

Sifei Wen: Concert Cellist, Entrepreneur, and Fashion Designer

Early Life and Musical Training

Sifei Wen's musical journey began in **Shanghai**, where *she* took up the cello at age 8 under the guidance of Professor MeiJuan Liu at the Shanghai Conservatory. At 13, she relocated to the **United States** to pursue advanced training, studying with the renowned cellist **Eleonore Schoenfeld** at the **University of Southern California's Thornton School of Music**. After Professor Schoenfeld's passing, Wen continued her studies at **Yale University** under the distinguished cellist **Aldo Parisot**, further refining her technique and artistry. This solid foundation, under two of the world's leading cello

Rise as a Concert Cellist and Musical Achievements

By her early 20s, Sifei Wen had emerged as a **versatile cellist** and garnered an impressive list of accomplishments. *She* has performed as a **recitalist, orchestra soloist, and chamber musician** on prominent stages worldwide. A defining moment of Wen’s career came in **2014**, when she accomplished a **groundbreaking feat in classical performance**. Under the mentorship of Bulgarian violinist **Daniel M. Tringov** (who had begun tutoring Wen in 2008 and helped her develop a hybrid cello-violin technique), she undertook an ambitious project to **interpret Antonio Vivaldi’s entire “The Four Seasons” concertos on the cello**. *She* gave the **world premiere** of this special cello transcription with the Sofia Soloists at Bulgaria Hall in Sofia in April 2014. The performance was a **resounding success**, drawing an audience so large that the venue exceeded capacity. This pioneering **Vivaldi project** established Wen as the first cellist known to perform the complete *Four Seasons* cycle in its original form on her instrument. In addition to memorable performances, Wen has **distinguished herself in numerous prestigious competitions**. Musical Style and Recordings

Wen's artistry is characterized by a **"cello bel canto" style**, a term referencing the "beautiful singing" approach traditionally associated with Italian opera. This distinctive style—**21st-century cello bel canto**—is highlighted in Wen's first solo album, *"Noël Cello Angel – The Acapella Playlist"* (released 2022). Recorded at Munich's Dorian Gray Studios, the album was a boutique release on the **Deutsche Classical** label in high-resolution audio and 4K video formats, emphasizing Wen's commitment to **ultra-high-quality production** for classical media. Alongside this album, Wen has **recorded core repertoire** including Bach's *Six Cello Suites*, Brahms' cello sonatas, and others, which are slated for limited-edition releases via her label. These projects reflect her dedication to *reinventing classical performance practice*, whether by presenting canonical works in new ways or by collaborating on contemporary compositions. Entrepreneurship and Deutsche Classical (2019)

Beyond performing, Sifei Wen has become a formidable **entrepreneur and artistic director**. Together with Daniel M. Tringov (now her husband and a concert violinist/producer), Wen **co-founded the record label "Deutsche Classical" in 2019, in Munich**. As **Co-founder and Director of Deutsche Classical**, she spearheads an innovative boutique classical music label which produces and distributes **ultra high-end audio and video content** in the classical genre. The label focuses on **elite artists and cutting-edge multimedia projects** that bring classical music to modern audiences in immersive formats. Under Wen's leadership, Deutsche Classical supports other musicians and has launched creative initiatives like the **Bavarian Chamber Players society** (an international chamber ensemble) and the **Global ART Prix** competition to foster emerging talent. April 30, 2014: *Four Seasons* Cello World Premiere

Performs as the first cellist to play Vivaldi's entire *The Four Seasons* in original form (with the Sofia Soloists in Bulgaria), drawing a standing-room-only crowd and broad acclaim.



2019: Co-founds *Deutsche Classical* Label

Co-establishes *Deutsche Classical* in Munich with Daniel Tringov. The international classical music label produces ultra high-end audio-video content and supports elite artists under Wen's leadership as director.



Jan 2021: Launch of *SW 27 Fashion Boutique*

Expands into fashion entrepreneurship by starting the *SW 27-Fashion Boutique* in Munich, offering couture designs made for and by classical performers, blending musical artistry with high fashion.

Releases her first solo album, *Noël Cello Angel – The Acapella Playlist*, featuring 11 multi-tracked solo cello pieces in her signature bel canto style. The album is issued in boutique high-fidelity formats via *Deutsche Classical*.



Dec 2024: *Forbes Gala Performance*

Gives a headline performance at the *Forbes Bulgaria Annual Gala Dinner*, featuring selections from *The Four Seasons* with multimedia elements (3D visual mapping), exemplifying her ability to blend classical music with modern event production.



2025–2026: *New Collaborations & Future Plans*

Scheduled to premiere British composer Nimrod Borenstein's *Cello Concerto No. 2* with the London Royal Philharmonic Orchestra, reflecting her commitment to championing new classical works and expanding her global presence.

Additional Achievements and Milestones

Born on **December 27, 1986**, in **Shanghai, China**, **Sifei Wen** does not simply enter a room—**she arrives like a composition reaching its most luminous crescendo**. A concert cellist by discipline and a high-fashion auteur by instinct, Wen has built a universe where music, couture, and beauty collide with cinematic force. "For me, beauty is not about disguise—it is about revelation," Wen says of the line. *"I wanted the cosmetic collection to feel like music translated into color: intense, elegant, emotional, and impossible to ignore."* Of ***"Music of Your Lips"***, she describes the lipstick as *"a performance in miniature—one movement of the hand, one shade against the skin, one moment when a woman decides how the world will remember her."*

Looking ahead, Wen imagines the cosmetic line as the first chapter of a larger beauty maison—one built at the intersection of couture, performance, and personal mythology. ***"My future plan is to create a beauty universe with the discipline of haute couture and the emotional power of a concert,"*** she says. ***"Every product should feel composed: the color, the texture, the weight in the hand, the memory it leaves behind. Inspirations

Sifei Wen's inspirations live where discipline begins to dream.
