Sacramento Camellia Society History - Joan Lesmeister

In 1959, "Favorite Camellias in Sacramento" were listed in the show program. A white variety was "Frizzle White", a 1935 introduction, but it seems to have frizzled out. "Purity", a 1890's gift to the USA from Japan, is a favorite we can still see at shows. Another favorite is "Lady Clare", a deep pink 1887 introduction! Many reds are still favorites like "Adolph Audusson", he came to us from France in 1887. And there's usually "Mathotiana" entries at our shows these days, because she's so beautiful. She came to the USA from Europe in the 1840's. "Pink Perfection" is still a favorite! She was an 1890's



lovely gift to the camellia world from Japan. Many variegated favorites were listed like "Daikagura" from Japan in the 1890's & "Ville de Nantes" from France in 1910. I was surprised to see how many familiar names are on that list, and how really very, very old they are! Will you be entering any of these varieties in our show this year?

Camellia Culture

Oh my gosh . . . where did the past year go? Camellia show season is near . . . are you ready? IF not, here is a partial list of things to do:

- Have you disbudded?
- Pruned plant limbs that prevent blooms from fully opening?
- Moved plants to a protected area?
- Modified watering when it rains?
- Cleaned flower boxes to bring blooms to the show?

- Clothes pins to pin back leaves?
- Cleaned flower clippers?
- Checked your vehicle?
- Made out a show list of blooms?
- Made out show cards?
- Done all the tasks you forgot last year?
- Plus,, plus, plus . . .you had better hurry, the 1st Camellia show is LESS than two weeks away!!
