CAMELLIA CULTURE CORNER~ DON LESMEISTER

Looks as if Mother Nature has suddenly thrown everyone a weather curve requiring adjustments to our Camellia growing habits. For example, for container grown plants, I usually water every 5 or so days in the normal winter weather. IF it rains, I then add another day. This year, it has rained several days in a row, which has extended my watering cycle to over a week.

Regarding gibbing, I usually try to gib on days when the afternoon temperature is around 50 degrees. This has happened only one day here, so my gibbing has been pretty well limited to varieties and plants that I haven't seen bloom before. AND, the weather forecast here is for the next week of 30 degree morning temperatures only one day in the high 40 degrees. Fortunately, gibbing does not a replace plant growing problems. The bud set on most plants here have been excellent. However, there has been very few blooms. It would appear that the later shows will have an abundance of blooms.

One thing you should pay attention to is the Judges Symposium. The Symposium will be held on Feb 5, 2022 in Pleasant Hill, Ca by Don Bergamini. Check your ACS Judges Certificate to make sure it has not expired. Your certificate can be extended for 5 years. If you want to become a Novice Judge, etc., or just want to attend, check with an Accredited Judge for details. There will also be a Mini Show. Your lunch order must be placed on or before Feb 2, 2022.
