THIS MONTH'S PLANT RAFFLE—Bill Kitagawa

Chris Bergamini—Japonica. White, striped with varying shades of pinks and reds. Miniature to small, anemone form.

Water Lily—Hybrid. Lavender tinted bright pink. Medium, formal Double.

Nuccio's Bella Rossa Var—Japonica. Red blotched white. Large, Formal double.

filaments. At times there may be pink shading on the petals. Large to very large, semidouble to loose peony with an occasional anemone flower.

CAMELLIA CULTURE CORNER~ DON LESMEISTER

As we enter the Fall, if your camellia plants have not set flower buds yet, the chances are narrowing that will occur. But, there are still a few things you can do to increase the odds of bud set. First, give your plants a full dose of 0-10-10. Next, if your plants are in containers, you can move them to a sunnier location. Your plants can take full sun until noon or 2 p.m. at this time of year.

IF we have rain, you can increase the days between watering. HOWEVER, they still require moisture.

Most people GIB (gibberellic acid) their plants beginning the end of November or first of December. If you do not have GIB and need help, give me a call at 916-742-3443. I will bring prepared GIB to the regular November meeting and give you a short lesson on how to apply GIB. If you don't call before the meeting, I won't bring any. The cost will be \$1 max for enough to GIB over 100 blooms.
