YOU MAY ENTER NO MORE THAN THREE (3) DRAWINGS. PLEASE PRINT YOUR NAME AND PHONE NUMBER IN PENCIL ON THE BACK OF THE DRAWING.

THE BUTTON MUST HAVE A MINIMUM OF ONE CAMELLIA BLOOM PICTURED. CAMELLIAS COME IN WHITE, PINK AND RED, LIGHT PINK TO DARK RED, INCLUDING COMBINATIONS OF ANY TWO OF THE COLORS, PINK, RED OR WHITE. THERE ARE A FEW THAT ARE A PALE YELLOW. THE CAMELLIA(S) SHOULD HAVE LEAF/LEAVES ATTACHED. (See website for some pictures)

THE FINAL BUTTON SIZE WILL BE 1-3/4 INCHES IN DIAMETER.

YOU MAY USE AS MANY COLORS AS YOU LIKE, BUT THE SIMPLER THE BETTER, AS THE BUTTON IS VERY SMALL. THE CLEANER THE BUTTON, THE BETTER. BE CREATIVE!

FIVE photo sections. Camellia(s) must be in each photo.

Section #1. Single RED Camellia

Section #2. Camellias with a child/children

**Section #3.** Camellias with pet/pets, animals

**Section #4.** Camellias used in landscape

**Section #5.** Humorous – no animals or children



### RULES:

- Contestants must be Amateur photographers. The public is invited.
- Contestants may enter in any or all 5 categories. Please, only one entry per household in each category. Please do not use photos previously entered.
- All entries must be 8 x 10, vertical, or horizontal, and displayed in a 11 x 14 black mat. (Mats available at art stores - Michael's, Hobby Lobby, Staples, or online.)
- Entries must have the photographer's name, address, and phone number on the <u>back</u> of each photo mat. It should not be visible from the front.
- 5. In addition, contestants need to fill a Camellia entry card to submit with each photo. These are completed the same way as if you were entering a bloom. Example, Front of card: Section No. <u>1</u>, Variety Red Camellia. Inside of card need only be the exhibitor's name & address in both places.
- All photos, with completed entry cards, should be placed in the correct photo section by 10:00 am, Saturday, March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025. Photos will be returned.
- 7. Photos will be judged on the overall quality of the composition with emphasis on the Camellia bloom(s).
- 8. Ribbons and trophies will be awarded to winners in each division.
