CAMELLIA CULTURE CORNER~ JIM TOLAND

End of season; now what?

Oh yeah...what about all those plants I promised to transplant? A careful check showed many had lost some of their top soil from wind, erosion, those big fat slugs, and other mysteries of plant culture. Other plants suddenly need larger pots.

...and I need to start applying fertilizer. How often? Once a month, until I get better advice. When to begin? About the time of the last show! How much? My plants will take the best part of \$100 worth of any kind I can find. I know the experts end up with complex mixes. The one rule I remember is that it is better to under fertilize than to over do it. Camellia plants are fairly delicate so I will take it easy. I will read all directions carefully on any bag, box, or bottle of fertilizer I use.

The big job this year is to keep my plants watered. Many will make it on watering twice a week if it's not too hot for too long and if my plants have plenty of soil that is protected from evaporation by a thick layer of mulch. The key is checking the plants frequently.
