CAMELLIA CULTURE CORNER~ DON LESMEISTER

As we head into December, there are a few culture items that we must remember to accomplish to assure we have quality Camellia blooms, whether it is for our own enjoyment or for later exhibition.

WATERING

This is the single most important item we must master in order to have quality blooms. For plants in containers, you should reduce the amount of water given. This is due to the plants going into dormancy and with cooler days, less water is evaporated. Therefore, we should adjust the watering system from every 3 to 4 days to every 5 to 7 days. In addition, we must consider the frequency and amount of each rainy day. A good rule of thumb is to increase the watering one day for every 1/4 inch of rain, or one additional day between watering for every rainy day. For example, if you water on

Monday, your next watering could be on Saturday. However, if it rains on Wednesday, you wouldn't need to water until Sunday. OR, if it rains 1/2 inch on Wednesday, you wouldn't need to water until Sunday. OR, if it rains 1/2 inch on Wednesday, you wouldn't have to water until Monday. For plants in the ground, you can increase the watering cycle an additional day. For example, if you water on Monday, the next watering wouldn't be necessary until Sunday, and add an additional day for rain.

However, if there is going to be a cold spell, or a night at 32 degrees or less, you want to make sure to water your plants that day, regardless of when you watered last. If the weather is going to be freezing for three consecutive nights, only water on the first day. This applies to plants

whether they are in the ground or in containers.

DISBUD

Another disbudding trip should be made to your plants. This will give you an opportunity to see if you did a good disbudding job on your first trip, or to re-work plants like Hybrids that have set additional flower buds.

FERTILIZER

Sometime during December, you should give your plants another application of either 0-10-10 or 2-10-10.

PRUNING

You can also use this time to do some minor trimming on your plants where branches need to be removed so flowers can open fully without touching which will damage flower petals.

After doing this, you can relax and watch football! Don
