

CAMELLIA CULTURE CORNER

Our Culture Expert...Don Lesmeister

Merry Christmas and Happy New Year to all! My Camellias seem to be blooming a LOT earlier than normal, and also earlier than last year. But it sure is nice to have flowers around the house. I have records dating back over 30 years that show December is the coldest month of the year. We may not be able to change what Mother Nature has in mind, but there are a few things we can do to help our Camellia plants. When weather reports predict 32 degrees or colder days, make sure your plants are watered in advance of this cold weather. Water the same amount and don't OVER water. Plants will absorb the water usually within a couple of hours, so you can water at night so long as you have a few hours before the freeze sets in. The coldest time of day is when the sun rises, so don't water in EARLY morning on freezing days. This does more damage than good. If you have plants setting off the ground on stands, etc, take them off and set on the ground. The ground or bark bases are far better than cement or rock bases. If you have a covered overhang, place them under this, even if the base is cement. Wait until AFTER the freeze is over to do additional bud removal. Many Camellias, especially Reticulatas, drop their buds as a result of cold weather. Wait a week or so after the freeze before you disbud. The time to use 0-10-10 or 2-10-10 has passed. Camellias are in their dormant stage, so now is an excellent time to transplant. You can transplant from container to container without any problems. I would suggest waiting until after the freeze danger is over before you transplant the larger plants out of the ground. In ground transplanting, remember the feeder roots (those closest to the top of the soil), are the most portant not to disturb. Trim the top branches of the plant in proportion to the roots damaged in transplanting, and apply Vitamin B-1 to avoid shock.....Good luck Don


