Looking forward to seeing you all at our first show and meeting on February 2, 2019! We will be at the Elks Lodge, #1, 6446 Riverside Blvd, Sacramento CA, from 9am to 3pm!! This meeting of the Council will include a **mini show**, open to all! Good place to enter our early blooms, and get some practice in for our new rules.... including cup sizes & one cup per entry! Come to our January society meeting and Don L. will go over the new rules with us!

Camellia Culture by Don Lesmeister

Well, blooming season is just starting, & soon the Camellia Shows begin. Take a last look at your plants, and disbud as necessary. Also do some minor pruning, mainly to assure branches do not prevent the blooms from opening. If you need to re-containerize any plants, now is the time to do so. Plants can be moved up one size in containers nearly any time of the year, so long as the roots are not significantly disturbed. However, re-containerizing large plants to 15 gallon or larger containers, or if roots are significantly disturbed should only be done when they are dormant, which is NOW. If you need to transplant Camellia plants that are in the ground, now is the perfect time. If you need to do so, be sure not to damage any of the feeder roots, which are near the top of the ground. You can cut off deeper roots, if needed, but be sure the roots are deeper in the soil. Lastly, the bloom entry rules for the Sacramento Camellia Show are changing regarding use of number of cups, cup size and items used in the cup, such as cotton. We should have Show schedules covering
