### | Camellia culture corner~ Jim Toland

As your camellias finish blooming, and before the temperature heats up, is a great time to do your serious pruning. Remove dead wood and



overlapping branches and twigs. Prune to open up the plant so that air circulates throughout. Prune to manage the height and the shape of the plant so that it meets your preferences and garden situation. For example, if you intend to show your flowers, you will probably wish to maintain your camellia plants at a height that keeps the flowers within reach. Make sure that your pruning tools

are clean and sharp. As with pruning other plants, it is good practice to sanitize your pruning shears with something like Lysol before moving from one plant to another. Keep an eye out for insect infestations, like scale, which can weaken the plant. Removing the infected twigs or small branches can be an effective way to solve insect problems and to reinvigorate your camellias.

### THIS 'N THAT

- Be sure and rake up all spent blooms beneath your camellias to prevent petal blight...Be sure and put in the GARBAGE, not GREEN WASTE
- Water, water, water...the weather is getting warmer.
