

### CAMELLIA CULTURE CORNER~ JIM TOLAND

Camellia is a genus of flowering plants in the family Theaceae. They are found in eastern and southern Asia, from the Himalayas east to Japan and Indonesia. There are 100–250 described species, with some controversy over the exact number. The genus was named by Linnaeus after the Jesuit botanist Georg Joseph Kamel, who worked in the Philippines, though he never described a camellia. This genus is famous throughout East Asia: camellias are known as cháhuā

(茶花) in Chinese. "tea flower", an apt designation, as tsubaki (椿) in Japanese, as dongbaek-kkot (동백꽃) in Korean and as *hoa trà* or hoa chè in Vietnamese. Of economic importance in the Indian subcontinent and Asia. leaves of C. sinensis are processed to create the popular beverage, tea. The ornamental Camellia japonica. Camellia oleifera and Camellia sasangua and their hybrids are represented in cultivation by a

large number of cultivars.

Jim Toland has graciously taken on our Camellia Culture Corner this year! He was a member of the Northern California Camellia Society for about 30 years, with 25 years as a member of the Camellia Research Committee, an off-shoot of NCCS.



# THIS 'N THAT

- Are you disbudding? Be sure and gently twist off any buds that are pointing UP in a cluster. You want only ONE bud, pointing DOWN (so that rain won't accumulate in the bloom).
- Check when you think about it, as those buds they show up overnight!
- Fertilize after <u>watering well</u>. The north winds have really dried out everything. Use 0-10-10 or 2-10-10 fertilizer.
