Once completed, either return it to our Office or drop it in the collection basket.

Parish membership is required for the reception of the Sacraments of Baptism, First Reconciliation, First Eucharist and Confirmation. Registration is also required before our Pastor can issue a certificate for those asked to be sacramental sponsors.

**Matrimony:** Arrangements should be made 6 months in advance by contacting our Wedding Coordination via the Parish office. Participation in marriage preparation is required by the Diocese of Saint Petersburg.

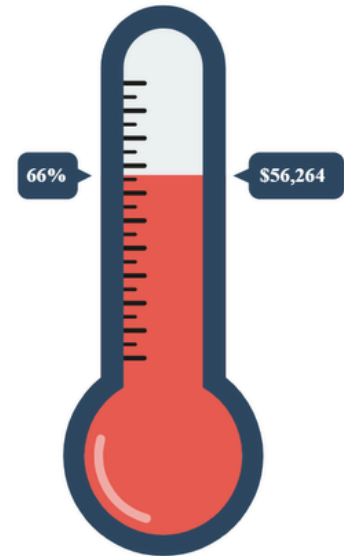

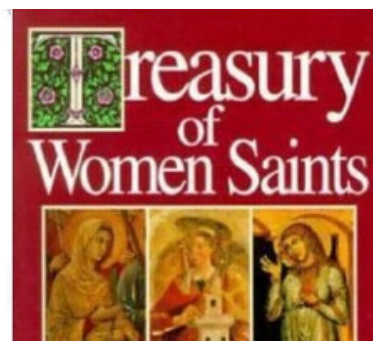
