Once completed either return it to our Office or drop it in the collection basket.

Membership is required for the reception of the Sacraments of Baptism, First Reconciliation, First Eucharist, and Confirmation. Registration is also required before the pastor can issue a certificate for those asked to be sacramental sponsors.

Matrimony: Arrangements should be made 6 months in advance by contacting our Wedding Coordinator via the parish office. Participation in marriage preparation is required by the Diocese of Saint Petersburg.

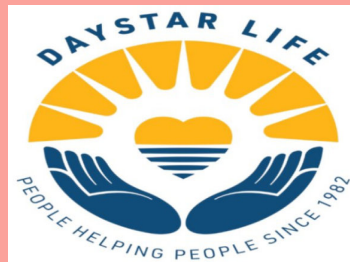

Stay Safe in the Heat

- Outdoors: Stay in shade, take breaks, wear light clothing, and plan activities for cooler times (morning or evening).
- Indoors: Use air conditioning or fans.
- Hydration: Drink plenty of water; limit sugary, salty, caffeinated, and alcoholic drinks. Light yellow urine indicates good hydration.

Muscle cramps, heavy sweating, shortness of breath, irregular
heartbeat, dizziness, headache, confusion, weakness, or nausea.

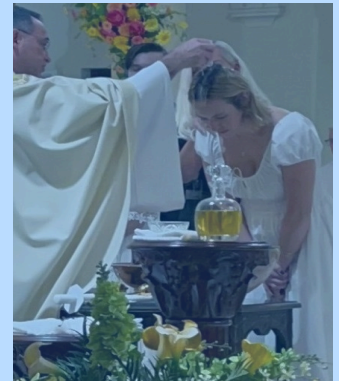


Invitation to Journey With Christ

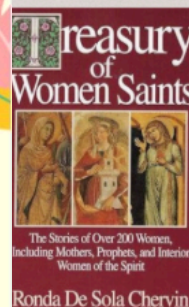

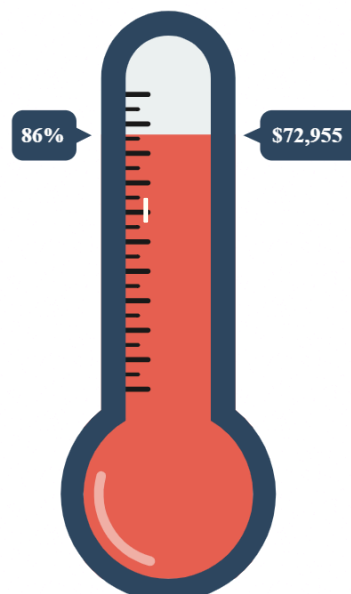
