




Pope Leo XIV has proclaimed a special Jubilee Year coinciding with the 800th anniversary of the death of Saint Francis of Assisi. According to the decree, Pope Leo has established that from Jan. 10, 2026 until Jan. 10, 2027, a special Year of Saint Francis may be proclaimed. The Apostolic Penitentiary also announced that plenary indulgences will be granted to Catholics "under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father), which can also be applied in the form of suffrage for the souls in Purgatory." The indulgence will be granted to those who participate in a pilgrimage "to any Franciscan Church, or place of worship in any part of the world named after Saint Francis or connected to him for any reason."

In solidarity with this papal decree, Saint Mary Our Lady of Grace will display the statue of Saint Francis with his relic in the church beginning March 7-8, and holy cards will be available near the statue for all.

Our Solemn Vesper service on Sunday, March 15 at 5:00 pm will also be in honor of this anniversary. All are welcome to come and pray that evening and stay for a Soup Supper in the parish hall!
