Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.
















### **ADULT FAITH FORMATION**

The Diocese of Saint Petersburg intends to serve God by completing **1,000,000 Works of Mercy**. We are calling this our "Acts of Mercy Challenge". Please join us! All you need to do is serve God through one (or more) of the Corporal or Spiritual Works of Mercy.

This week, we explore PUTTING INTO PRACTICE the CORPORAL WORKS of MERCY:

**Feed the Hungry:** Prepare a meal for your family and schedule at least one family meal per week. Put your phone away when eating with others. Volunteer at DAYSTAR!

<u>Give Drink to the Thirsty:</u> Invite a friend, neighbor or family member to Mass (those who thirst for the knowledge of God). Donate baby formula.

<u>Clothe the Naked:</u> Provide baby clothes to a local crisis pregnancy center. Finding the grace to be patient while dealing with a toddler who only wants to wear the blue shirt or help a teen dress attractively, yet modestly.

**Shelter the Homeless:** Build a house with Habitat for Humanity. Help local refugees. Welcome parishioners at the beginning and end of Mass.

<u>Visit the Sick:</u> Visiting the sick can start with your family who might be having a tough day by offering hot tea, a back rub, or making their favorite dish, etc. Drop off dinner to someone whose family member is sick.

<u>Visit the Imprisoned:</u> Provide Bibles, prayer books, or other religious literature for prisoners. Help the families of prisoners.

**<u>Bury the Dead:</u>** Join a respect life ministry or participate in their events. Volunteer with cemetery cleanup days.

You can do this as an individual, with a friend, with family, or as a team. NEXT week, we'll explore the SPIRITUAL WORKS OF MERCY. Also, make sure you visit the diocesan website and submit your work of mercy. www.Mercy2025.org
