

Tour Policies

Purse Payout & Points

We follow **USGA** rules for paying prize money to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place positions on the ImpacTour.

- Players playing as *Professionals* will receive full prize money offered or stated by the ImpacTour.
 - **1st through 6th cash payout amounts on 48% net profits.**
- Players playing as *Amateurs* are not able to receive cash as winnings for a victory on the ImpacTour.
 - Such players can, however, receive a maximum of \$1,000 from the host country club or gift card retailer such as Dick's Sporting Goods.
- Should a combined *Professional/Amateur* team win an ImpacTour event: The *Professional* will receive his or her full portion of the payout amount, while the *Amateur* will receive his or her \$1,000 max script amount.

Scoring

- Scoring validated on each hole by volunteer(s).
- Bribing of any volunteer will result in immediate disqualification.

Practice Rounds/Rates

- Practice rounds are not included with an entry fee.
- Practice rounds and rate are contingent on course and/or availability.

Cancellation Policy

- Notification must be received 5 days prior to the tournament date to receive a full refund.
- No notification = no refund/credit/transfer.

Carts

- Included with entry fee
- Players can walk if preferred
- Pull carts are allowed

Electronic Devices

- The use of distance measuring devices (range finders, watches, etc.) are permitted in all ImpacTour events.
- Cell phones may be used to "live score," contact an official, check the leaderboard, check the weather, or to be used as an electronic distance-measuring device.
- Headphones and earbuds are not permitted for players during competitive rounds.
- Speakers of any kind are not allowed.

Withdrawal Policy

- A player or team may withdraw from an event for any reason before the event date.
- A player or team choosing to withdraw prior to the event day must contact an ImpacTour staff member via phone, text, or email.
- If no contact has been made prior to the event start day, the player or team will be considered a "no show" and will be denied a refund, credit, or transfer.

For player(s) or team choosing to withdraw prior to the start of the event, there are three withdrawal options:

- Refund – 100% of entry fee
- Entry credit

- Transfer entry fee to any future event

Refund(s)

- Refunds will post to the credit card used during registration (no exceptions).

Entry Fee Transfer(s)

- No cancellation fee will apply for players of teams choosing to transfer their entry fee.

***No refund, credit or transfer is available once a player has officially teed off in an event.*

Code of Conduct

Alcohol and Drugs

The illegal use of drugs or alcohol by players, family and/or guests is prohibited. Alcohol should not be brought onto the property. All food & beverage policies of the club should be followed.

Dress Code – Players

- Proper attire is required at all times on the golf course(s) and the practice facilities (clubhouse, putting & chipping greens and the driving range), by players, guests and volunteers.
- Slacks or golf shorts are permitted during tournament play and practice rounds.
- Non-permitted attire includes jeans, denim tank tops, tee shirts, basketball shorts, short shorts or short skirts, sweatpants, board shorts, spandex or bike shorts.

Any specific rules/policies that may be requested by host course will be addressed to competitors through the *Event Details* email that will be sent to participants prior to the event.

Spectators

Spectators are guests of the club and should avoid wearing jeans, t-shirts, short shorts, and similarly casual attire. Generally, golf attire is preferred. We hope that you will attend our events and be comfortable but ask that you respect the host club's policies. At few clubs, jeans are permitted on the golf course, and in those cases, jeans would be acceptable for spectators but not for players. When in doubt, please contact us or avoid jeans and more casual attire.

- Spectators are welcome to all ImpacTour events.
- COVID-19 host club/policies are subject to change each site.
- Spectators may be limited to remaining on cart paths and required to maintain a safe distance of participants.

Conduct

- As a *Professional* or *Amateur* golfer competing in an ImpacTour event, all players are expected to conduct themselves in a professional manner.
- Disorderly behavior includes:
 - **Excessive use of profanity and/or offensive language** - Disqualification after two (2) verbal warnings from Tour official(s).
 - **Club throwing** - Disqualification after two (2) verbal warnings from Tour official(s).
 - **Verbal or physical abuse, or threats of abuse to officials, volunteers, players, or staff** - Immediate disqualification.

- **Destruction of property** - Immediate disqualification.
- Any other conduct deemed by the Tournament Committee to be unprofessional.

*Any disqualification based on these offenses may result in temporary suspension or expulsion from the Tour.

Player's Responsibility for Family and Guests

Players in ImpacTour competitions are guests of the host club and accordingly, players are responsible for the behavior of their family and guests. Players may face withdrawal of their entry, and possible future suspension for the inappropriate behavior of their family members and guests. Players, family members or guests who repeatedly violate the code of conduct, or who are abusive to officials or club staff, may be suspended from attending future events.

Please refrain from policing any code of conduct issues. If you witness a code of conduct breach that is serious or have seen the same breach multiple times by a player, you may notify an official. **DO NOT HANDLE THE SITUATION YOURSELF.** Officials and the Tournament Chairman will be responsible for handling all code of conduct issues.
