The Reynoldsburg Education Foundation (REF) Board of Directors and Grants and Scholarships Committee are pleased to announce our second round of Mini-Grant Applications! We were honored to present four deserving mini-grant awards during our first round this past summer. Another opportunity exists for Reynoldsburg City School District teachers to apply for a **\$250 mini-grant** for the 2021-2022 school year.

Qualified applicants are individuals that have an assigned student roster and provide daily instruction (regular education teachers, special education teachers, tutors, unified arts). One grant will be awarded to each school/academy in mid-January. All grant recipients will receive grant funds by the end of January 2022 to be used for the current school year. Awardees will be invited to attend the annual Reynoldsburg Education Foundation Gala hosted September 2022.

Applications will be accepted October 15 – November 15, 2021.
