FOREWORD

Estudiantes is proudly affiliated with Club Estudiantes de La Plata and are a sport-for-development project that uses the power of sport to drive academic excellence.

The club is open to young people of all abilities, but, anyone who wants to train with or play for the club has to show the requisite commitment to their studies.

Despite the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic, the students and the team have made some remarkable strides this season. The attitude of the students to their education has been outstanding, with an average college attendance of over 92%.

The majority of our students study at Haringey 6th Form college, and we would like to place on record our thanks to the college, the CEO Russ Lawrance, and all of the staff for their support to run the club this year.

One of the most substantial developments this season has been the ability to train on a weekly basis at Haringey Borough Football Club. This has had a transformative effect on on-pitch performances. Resultantly, the club would like to put on record its thanks to is sponsors who has made this possibility available. Attendance at training has been excellent, with Joe and Darren putting on challenging yet enjoyable sessions on a weekly basis. The team were also fortunate enough to have FIFA's Maz Karim put them through their paces.

The club has played 28 matches. Highlights have included trips to Loughborough and Cambridge universities. To give an idea of the standard that they were at times competing against, a player who played for Loughborough was registered to play in this season's Europa League.

Trips to universities such as Cambridge and Loughborough are only partially about the match. For instance, we were privileged to have current Cambridge University student and Tottenham resident Saron Mehari speak to the students before the match detailing her journey to Cambridge.



Elsewhere, the team have also achieved hugely impressive results against Harlow Town reserves and the Players Pathway Academy - with the latter match played at Roots Hall, the 12,500 all-seater home of professional football club Southend United. They have also won the Tottenham Hotspur Foundation Summer Series men's five a side tournament.

Our futsal team have also enjoyed considerable success this season. The students had the chance to play against Helvecia, England's representative in the UEFA Champions League. Recently, Enrique Guillen, head coach of Helvecia has spent time coaching the students.

None of the above excellence would be possible without the complete dedication of the players and the generosity of Estudiantes de la Plata, Haringey 6th Form College, or the many, many volunteers who have given their time and expertise.

There are too many to mention all individually but we would like to give special thanks to Maria, Nico, Vishnu and Joe. Thank you very much for all of your help.

It is probably best to conclude on the future. Ultimately, the club's intention is to serve the needs of whoever joins the club. Therefore, the long-term goal of the club is for it to be as self-sufficient as possible - a sport-fordevelopment club run by the students and for the students.

REVIEW OF THE YEAR

Despite the challenges arising from the global Covid-19 pandemic, our students have excelled in their education whilst taking part in a regular football training program throughout the year and played 28 matches against teams from across the UK.

The training program at Haringey Borough FC that is provided to reward students displaying an excellent attitude to their studies has been well attended. This supports our belief that by providing high-quality opportunities, we can drive performance both in sport and education.

These opportunities would not have been possible without the support of our sponsors; UK Youth, Sported, London Youth, Sport England, The National Lottery Community Fund, The Woodward Charitable Trust, Joseph Harry, Sunanda Das, Haringey 6th Form, and our home kit sponsor Buen Ayre.

Our club has benefitted from the use of a Veo camera, that has helped us record and analyze games thanks to the efforts of David Potter and our coach Joe Worf.

Throughout the year, the students have had the chance to to visit and play against leading Universities, as well semi-professional football and futsal teams. Thank you to Maria Betancourt for all of her support at matches and training sessions this year. In May 2021, the students with the best attendance records in their academic programs were given chance to play at the home of professional club Southend United Football Club.

On a sporting front, notable highlights have been; Owen Locke's progression in elite futsal with Genesis, a futsal club that have supported our club for the last three years, Mohsin Mohamed earning a trial with one of England's top professional football clubs.

We were most proud of the improvement in performance of Isam Belmoudden. His attitude in both education and sport, embodied everything we want Estudiantes to represent. Isam attended 100% of his 413 college lessons at Haringey 6th Form College, passing GCSE Maths, as well as earning a Grade 6 in GCSE English. He also attended 141 football and futsal training sessions through the year, performing brilliantly in all matches, accomplishing all this whilst continuing to work part time.

Across the team, we have seen young people develop the skills and self-confidence to compete in high level sport.



Guest speakers and elite coaches have given their time to help the students progress, including Enrique Guillen of Helvecia, Joao Almeida of Loughborough University, Juan Tapia Owens of ProFutsal, and Maz Karim from FIFA. Saturday morning football and mentoring program with Taner Mustafa has been popular among students. Thank you to all of the above for giving their time.

On Social Media, Nico Cocchiararo, an Estudiantes de La Plata fan living in London, has attended events and games throughout the season and done brilliantly to grow the club's following and reputation and this has led to improved opportunities for the students. Thank you Nico! Thank you to George Williams Gunn for such wonderful graphic design and Hundred Fires and John Wiltshire for great photos.

We had an opportunity to visit the incredible Loughborough University where two of our graduates Fabio Teixiera and Tenzin Dhongak are now excelling as they complete their Sport Science degrees. Despite defeats against Loughborough in football and futsal matches, our students represented the club brilliantly. It is likely three more of our students will join Loughborough this summer.

We have been thankful for the support of leading futsal clubs Genesis, Helvecia, and the International Futsal Academy at Loughborough who provide our students with wonderful opportunities on and off the pitch. Coerver coaching, the world's best skill coaching method for children were kind enough to provide 4 spaces on their Coerver Youth Diploma for Dani, Abdullah, Isam and Djibril to gain the qualification.

The London FA and Amateur FA continue to support our club with us winning Charter Standard Club of the month in May 2021. Our Under 16 group played their first game in June 2021, led by our student Levin Dookhun.

Argentinian World Cup winner and Tottenham legend Osvaldo Ardiles was kind enough to be guest of honour at our end-of-season award ceremony that was kindly hosted by Haringey 6th College.


FINANCES

OVERVIEW

Estudiantes was registered as a Community Interest Company (CIC) on 28th May 2020. Until then, all operational and program-related costs were covered through donations by the two founders. Our registration as a CIC has allowed us to secure funding to cover our costs and raise more funding in the future as we expand our work.

INCOME

In 2020, we were able to raise £17,430 from a range of donors. Our biggest grant (£7,250) came from UK Youth. We also received grants totalling £6,990 from Sported, London Youth, The Woodward Charitable Trust, Sport England and The National Lottery. Finally, we received substantial donations from Joseph Harry (£2,000) and Sunanda Das (£500). We thank all our donors for their generous contributions.




EXPENDITURE

In 2020-21, total expenditure for Estudiantes totalled £7,276. Within this, the most significant expense was hiring sports pitches for matches and training. Pitch costs range between £100-250 per match, and we spent £2,747 on pitches over the last year.

To provide an elite level football and futsal program for our students and to showcase our students' performances for scholarship opportunities, we invested in a VEO camera for the one-off cost of over £1,721. This has allowed us to record all of our games, publish highlights and provide analysis to our students.

Other major expenses included sports kits, training equipment and transport for matches. Our directors have taken no money nor expenses.

FUTURE PLANS

Thanks to the generosity of our donors, we now have funding of £10,154 that will cover the costs of our various core programs for the next six months. As lockdown restrictions ease, we will provide more training sessions and matches this year.

More importantly, we also expect to increase the number of people participating in the program. This will be done carefully as we will continue to prioritize impact over participation numbers.

Specifically, we hope to introduce under-13 and under-16 groups and an inclusion team for students with special educational needs.

Our own participants, many of whom have FA coaching qualifications, will lead in the organization and delivery of youth coaching. In addition, we expect to use the government's Kickstart employability program to enable us to expand and improve our sports and education provision.

Since we are committed to running financially sustainable operations, we will continue to look for additional funding that will allow us to expand our program both in scale and scope. Alongside this, we will continue to attempt to develop positive relationships with organizations in sport, education and employment that can improve the opportunities we provide for our students.

One focus over the next year is to help our students secure sports scholarships to study in the USA. We believe that this a path to greater opportunities for several of our students.
