- Most importantly, the participants in our project are doing well. We have seen great attendance at training and matches, improved punctuality. Most importantly we have seen their college attendance improve to 96%.
- In defeat and victory this month, the students behaviour has been exemplary.
- The students had the chance to meet World Cup Winner Osvaldo Ardiles and Tottenham Hotspur first team player Harvey White at the opening of a new pitch at Haringey 6th Form College.
- To celebrate the anniversary of Estudiantes de La Plata becoming world club champions we will host an elite level futsal tournament on 16th October where we will compete against Genesis and Helvecia who are the best team in England and preparing for the UEFA Champions League in November
- Fabio returned from Loughborough at the beginning of the month, to play in a friendly game for us. He reported that he is settled into Loughborough, and really enjoying the challenges of playing for the futsal team.
- We are absolutely delighted that we have secured a home kit sponsor for the season. Buen Ayre in Hackney have been kind enough to support our team. - The students played in 6 friendly games since our Inauguration game against London Tibet. Winning 2, Losing 3 and drawing 1. Some excellent performances, most notably in drawing 0-0 with North West London, and a fine display to beat Bruce Castle United 5-1.
- The students punctuality has improved dramatically in this time, with attendance at training so high we will organise more sessions to meet the demand. The students training before college on Monday and Wednesday and after college on Thursday and Friday.

Ossie and Harvey open new football pitch in the local community

Club legend Ossie Ardiles and young midfielder Harvey White yesterday visited Haringey Sixth Form College on White Hart Lane to open a new football pitch.

Following a ribbon-cutting to mark the pitch officially open, Harvey took the first kick of a mini-match between college students and Estudiantes FC, a local club which combines football and education to help young people in the borough progress to university.

During the event, Harvey also got involved in football drills with his fellow teenagers, while Ossie watched on and gave the group some words of advice.

The new pitch, made from 3G artificial turf, forms part of major renovation works taking place at the college over the summer period.

It will give all students additional opportunities to take part in regular sport and exercise, with the aim of improving physical and mental health. The college's own football team, which competes in a local league, will also benefit from being able to train at the new facility.

New 3G pitch to improve physical and mental health of students

Haringey Sixth Form College have unveiled a new outdoor 3G pitch following extensive renovations made during the summer.

The opening ceremony was attended by Spurs and Argentinian World Cup winner, Osvaldo "Ossie" Ardiles, and current first team player Harvey White, who cut the ribbon. Other attendees included members of the local community, business representatives and other college stakeholders.

Guests were treated to a tour of the college, which has had over four million pounds invested into it in the last few years, to create an improved facility.

The 3G pitch is one of the many areas within the college to undergo major renovations, allowing for even greater sports provisions that will improve physical and mental health for all of the students. It is a part of a wider enrichment program that also includes music, performing arts, catering, drama and dance projects.

Spurs legend Ossie said: "It is a privilege to be here opening this new football pitch just around the corner from our stadium. "It makes me happy to know that it will help many local young people improve their football and lead healthy lives."

The launch event saw Haringey Sixth Form College take on local club Estudiantes FC.

Football coach and H6 Sports Enrichment Coordinator, Darren Wiltshire said: "Haringey Sixth Form football academy compete in the AOC college football league, with daily training and weekly games against other colleges in London.

"Estudiantes FC are an FA Charter Standard football club established to enable students from Tottenham to access top universities. They work to help students in the area gain qualifications and skills that can allow them to fulfil their potential."

Level two Public Services student, Isam Belmouden, said: "I am really pleased to have the opportunity to play on this new pitch. I am determined to get good grades and go onto a good university, and will also be a part of the football and futsal teams this year, so I am looking forward to the year ahead."

The launch was a great opportunity to see Spurs midfielder Harvey White in action. Harvey said: "The students here are all my sort of age and I really enjoyed meeting them today - taking the first kick of the game was an added bonus."

Russ Lawrence, Chief Executive of the College said: "It's fitting we had such a legend as Ossie to open this facility. I grew up watching him play - I am so grateful to him and the club for supporting us today. "New and upgraded facilities have a proven track record in increasing participation and performance, be this in education or in this case sport. At Haringey Sixth Form College we have invested any surplus we have back into the student experience. We are committed to working to achieve the best possible experience for our students. "I am keen to work with a range of partners across the city to ensure the right facilities, the right experiences, and opportunities are fully accessible to all our amazing students - they need and deserve the best."
