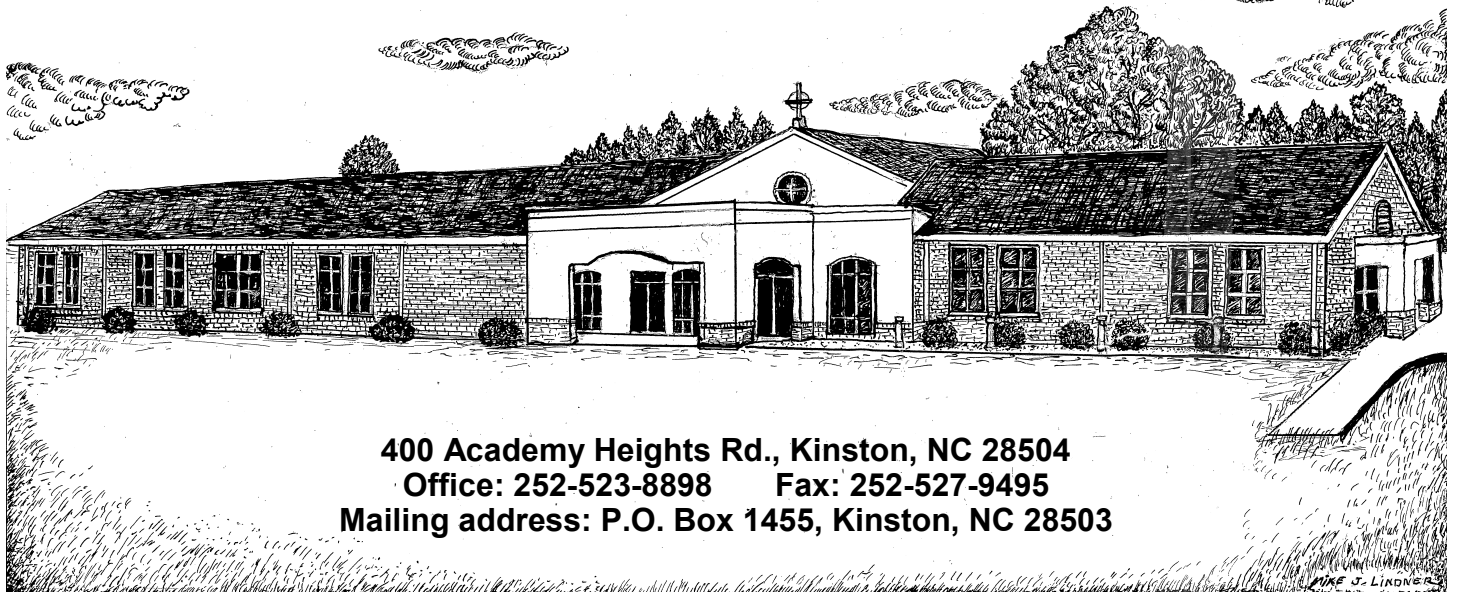

4. Do not open the door for strangers, even if they are from ICE, or if they say they have a piece of paper for you. Tell them to put it under the door or leave it outside.
5. Please never drive drunk, if you do and you are stopped you are certain to be deported.

5. Por favor NUNCA, maneje tomado, si lo hace y lo paran es deportación segura.

Saints of the Week

Tuesday, Sept. 15th: Our Lady of Sorrows; by the 14th century, the sorrows of Mary numbered seven: the presentation of Jesus in the Temple; the flight into Egypt; Jesus being lost in Jerusalem; the meeting of Mary and Jesus on the way to Calvary; the crucifixion; the taking down of Jesus' body from the cross; and his burial.

Wednesday, Sept. 16th: (1) Saint Cornelius, Pope, Martyr; died 253 in exile in Civitavecchia; opposed Novatian and the rigorists in the *lapsi* controversy; buried in the cemetery of Callistus.

(2) Saint Cyprian, Bishop, Martyr; decapitated 14 Sept. 258 under Valerian; ally of St. Cornelius; bishop of Carthage; wrote *On the Unity of the Catholic Church*; Cyprian disagreed with Pope Stephen I (reigned 254-257) over the question of the rebaptism of heretics and schismatics; first African bishop to be martyred; patron of North Africa and of Algeria.

Thursday, Sept. 17th: Saint Robert Bellarmine, Bishop, Doctor of the Church; died 1621 at age 79; Tuscan; brilliant Jesuit scholar, preacher, writer, and systematic apologist of the Counter Reformation; most noted for his Catechism; involved in the Galileo affair; cardinal archbishop of Capua; patron of catechists and catechumens.

Saturday, Sept. 19th: Saint Januarius, Bishop, Martyr; died 305 at age 33; according to his legend, thrown to bears at Pozzuolo under Diocletian; bishop of Benevento; as early as 1389, his blood has liquefied on this and other days each year; patron of Naples.
