



Saints of the Week

Wednesday, January 20th: Saint Sebastian, Martyr; died 288 at Rome under Diocletian; chief of the Praetorian cohort whose *acta* tell of his being pierced by arrows, later being clubbed to death; patron of archers, soldiers, and police associations.

Thursday, January 21st: Saint Agnes, Virgin, Martyr; died in the beginning of the 4th century under Diocletian at the age of twelve (so St. Augustine and St. Ambrose report); patroness of Christian virtue confronted by political and social violence; represented with a martyr's palm and a lamb; the wool from two lambs blessed today will be used to make the pallia which are represented by the pope to Metropolitans on 29 June.

Saturday, January 23rd: (1) Saint Vincent, Deacon, Martyr; died 304 in persecution of Diocletian at Valencia; deacon of the church of Saragossa; protomartyr of Spain.



January 22 Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children

The over 56 million abortions since the 1973 decision of Roe v. Wade and Doe v. Bolton reflect with heartbreaking magnitude what Pope Francis means by a “throwaway culture.” However, we have great trust in God’s providence. We are reminded time and again in Scripture to seek the Lord’s help, and as people of faith, we believe that our prayers are heard.

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal designates January 22 as a particular day of prayer and penance, called the “Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children”: “In all the Dioceses of the United States of America, January 22 (or January 23, when January 22 falls on a Sunday) shall be observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion.”

As individuals, we are called to observe this day through the penitential practices of prayer, fasting and/or giving alms. Another way to take part is through participating in special events to observe the anniversary of Roe v. Wade.
