



Second collections are optional. Parishioners are given this choice at the moment of passing the baskets.


Segunda Colecta del Siguiente Domingo

The Sunday of the Word of God

The Sunday of the Word of God, instituted by Pope Francis and to be held every year on the third Sunday of Ordinary Time, reminds us, of the importance and value of Sacred Scripture for the Christian life, as well as the relationship between the Word of God and the liturgy.

Among the many Saints, all of whom witness to the Gospel of Jesus Christ, Saint Jerome can be proposed as an example because of the great love he had for the Word of God. As Pope Francis has recalled, he was a “tireless [...] scholar, translator and exegete. [He had a] profound knowledge of the Scriptures, [and] zeal for making their teaching known. [...] In his attentive listening to the Scriptures, Jerome came to know himself and to find the face of God and of his brothers and sisters. He was also confirmed in his attraction to community life”.

Saints of the Week

Monday, January 23rd: (1) Saint Vincent, Deacon, Martyr; died in early 4th century, in the persecution of Diocletian at Valencia; deacon of the church of Saragossa; protomartyr of Spain; Prudentius (384-c.410), Spanish-born poet, sings his praises in his narrative poem, *Peristephanon*; patron of wine-producers (Vincent/vin assonance in French).

(2) Saint Marianne Cope, Virgin; died 1918; a religious of the Sisters of St. Francis of Syracuse, NY; known for her charitable works and virtuous deeds. For thirty-five years cared for the lepers on the island of Moloka'i. She was canonized by Pope Benedict XVI on 21 October 2012.

Tuesday, January 24th: St. Francis de Sales, Bishop, Doctor of the Church; died 1622; bishop of Geneva; sought to bring many back to the Church through his personal life and writings, especially his *Controversies* and several devout treatises, including his *Introduction to the Devout Life*; co-founder with St. Jane Frances de Chantal of the Visitation Order; patron of writers, journalists, and the deaf.

Thursday, Jan. 26th: Saints Timothy and Titus, Bishops; Timothy from Lystra in Asia Minor and Titus of Greek origin (Antioch on the Orontes?); companions of Paul and overseers of the churches of Ephesus and Crete, respectively; recipients of the so-called pastoral epistles.

Friday, Jan. 27th: Saint Angela Merici, Virgin; died 1540 at age 66 at Brescia; orphaned at ten; foundress of the Ursulines, the first teaching order especially for poor young girls; sought re-evangelization of families through the education of future wives and mothers.

Saturday, Jan. 28th: Saint Thomas Aquinas, Priest, died 1274 at the age of 49, Doctor of the Church; the “Angelic Doctor” who wrote the *Summa Theologiae* and authored *Adoro te devote*, *O salutaris*, *Tantum ergo*, and *Pange lingua*; patron of Catholic schools, colleges, and universities; of philosophers, theologians, and booksellers.

El Domingo de la Palabra de Dios

El Domingo de la Palabra de Dios, instituido por el Papa Francisco en el III Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario de cada año, recuerda a todos la importancia y el valor de la Sagrada Escritura para la vida cristiana, como también la relación entre la Palabra de Dios y la liturgia.

Entre los numerosos santos, testigos todos del Evangelio de Jesucristo, puede ser propuesto como ejemplo san Jerónimo por el gran amor que tuvo a la Palabra de Dios. Como ha recordado recientemente el Papa Francisco, él fue “un incansable estudiante, traductor, exégeta, profundo conocedor y apasionado divulgador de la Sagrada Escritura. [...] Poniéndose a la escucha, Jerónimo se encontró a sí mismo en la Sagrada Escritura, como también el rostro de Dios y de los hermanos, y afinó su predilección por la vida comunitaria”.
