



## Saints of the Week

**Tuesday, Dec. 6th:** Saint Nicholas, Bishop; died 4th century; bishop of Myra in Asia Minor; model pastor noted for charity; popularized as Santa Claus (anglicized from Dutch "Sinter Claus"); patron of children, bankers, pawnbrokers, sailors, perfumers, brides, unmarried women, travelers, fishermen, dock workers, brewers, poets, and prisoners; also of Russia, Greece, Sicily, Lorraine, and Apulia in Italy where his relics are enshrined in Bari.

Wenesday, Dec. 7th: Saint Ambrose, Bishop, Doctor of the Church, died on Holy Saturday at age 57; born in Trier of noble parents; classically educated; while a catechumen, chosen by popular acclaim as bishop of Milan and consecrated Dec. 7th, 374; his allegorical exegesis and rhetorical skill made him a compelling preacher; defender of orthodoxy against Arianism; brought Theodosius to public penance; composed several liturgical hymns; baptized Augustine; along with Sts. Jerome, Augustine and Gregory I, declared one of the four great doctors of the Latin Church by Pope Boniface VIII in 1298.

**Thursday, Dec. 8th:** The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary; Patronal Feast Day of the USA; chosen by God, Mary reverses the sin of Eve; because of her obedience, God's salvation is made known to all the nations; originating in the 7th century feast of the "Conception of Mary by St. Anne," Pope Clement XI, in his Bull, *Commissi Nobis*, established this Solemnity for the entire Church in 1708; patroness of the United States of America, Spain, Tanzania, and the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

**Friday, Dec. 9th:** Saint Juan Diego; died 1548 at age 74. Baptized at about age 50, this Mexican Indian was walking to Mass on December 9, 1531, when Mary appeared to him on Tepeyac Hill, near Mexico City. Speaking in his native language of Náhuatl, she asked him to petition the bishop for a shrine to be built there. But the bishop asked for a sign. On December 12, Juan returned to Tepeyac; Mary told him to pick flowers blooming atop the hill and put them in his cloak to take to the bishop. When Juan opened the cloak, the flowers fell out and the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe adorned his garment. This miraculous image is preserved in the famous basilica in Mexico City. Juan lived out his days as a hermit near the first chapel built there; he was canonized in 2002.

**Saturday, Dec. 10th:** Our Lady of Loreto; recently added (31 October 2019) by Pope Francis to the Roman Calendar, the Optional Memorial of Our Lady of Loreto recalls the mystery of the Incarnation. Since the Middle Ages, veneration for the Holy House of Loreto has powerfully illustrated the evangelical virtues of the Holy Family. A Marian Litany, also known as the Litany of Loreto, has its first-known origins at the Shrine of Our Lady of Loreto (Italy), where its usage was recorded as early as 1558. Our Lady of Loreto is the patron saint of Aviation.
