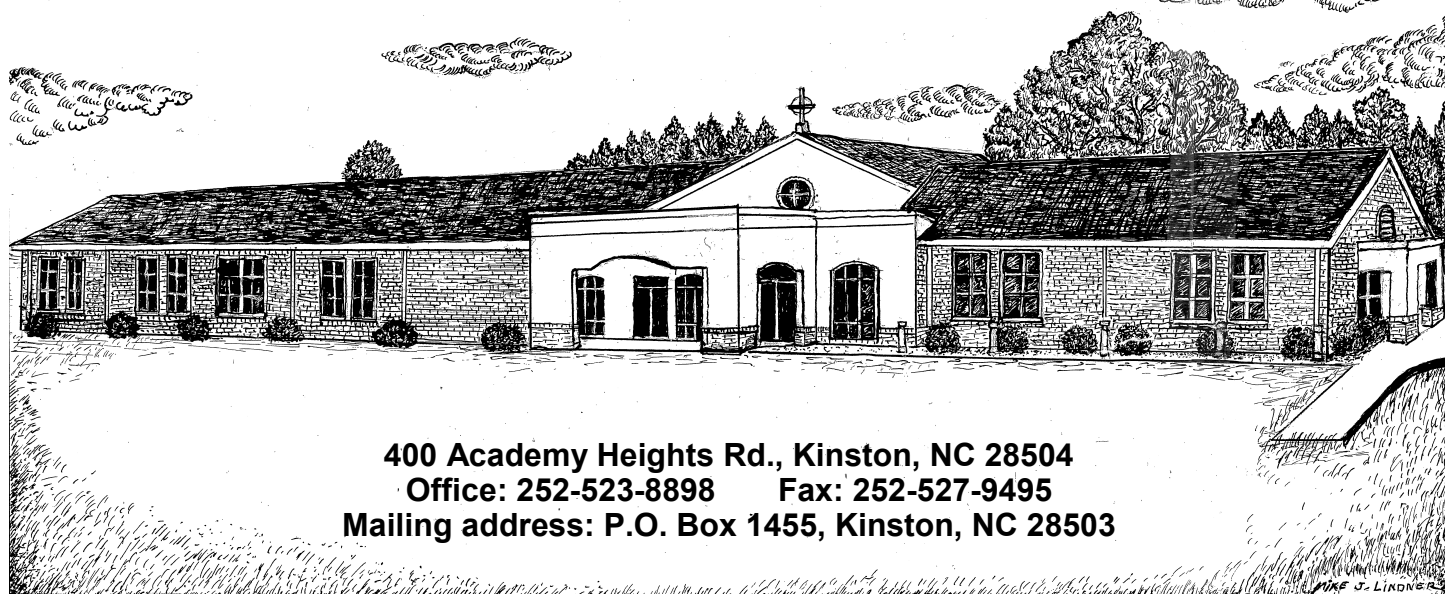

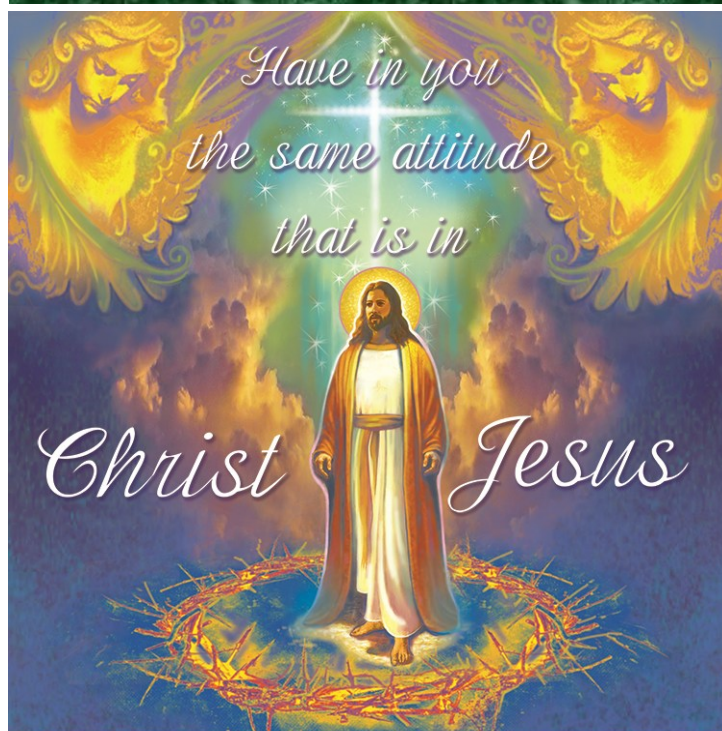

4. Do not open the door for strangers, even if they are from ICE, or if they say they have a piece of paper for you. Tell them to put it under the door or leave it outside.
5. Please never drive drunk, if you do and you are stopped you are certain to be deported.

5. Por favor NUNCA, maneje tomado, si lo hace y lo paran es deportación segura.

Saints of the Week

Monday, Sept. 28th: (1) Saint Wenceslaus, Martyr; died 929 at age twenty-two; duke of Bohemia; sought to bring the faith to his people; killed by his pagan brother, Boleslaus; patron of the Czech Republic and Slovakia.

(2) Saint Lawrence Ruiz and Companions, Martyrs; today the Church commemorates sixteen martyrs (thirteen Dominicans and three Tertiaries) of Nagasaki, Japan, during the years 1633-1637; they included nine Japanese, four Spaniards, one Frenchman, an Italian, and the Philippino, Lawrence Ruiz, the father of a family and protomartyr of the Philippines; after enduring horrible tortures, their bodies were burned and their ashes scattered by order of the ruler, Tokugawa Yemitsu.

Tuesday, Sept. 29th: Saints Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael, Archangels; these biblical messengers signify God's transcendence and loving care: Michael (meaning "Who is like God?"), Gabriel ("God's Strength"), and Raphael ("God's Remedy"); Michael: patron of security forces and of the sick; Gabriel: of telecommunications and the postal service; Raphael: of travelers and the blind.

Wednesday, Sept. 30th: Saint Jerome, Priest, Doctor of the Church; died 420 at Bethlehem; from Dalmatia; devoted monk and ascetic; wrote numerous commentaries on and authored Latin ("Vulgate") translation of the Bible; one of the four great doctors of the Latin Church; patron of scripture scholars; he said "Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ".

Thursday, Oct. 1: Saint Therese of the Child Jesus, Virgin, Doctor of the Church; "Little Flower" died 30 Sept. 1897 of tuberculosis in the Carmel of Lisieux at age 24; born in Alencon; contemplative who, in her autobiography, *The Story of a Soul*, urged all to follow "the little way"; proclaimed a doctor of the Church by Pope John Paul II, 19 October 1997; patroness of the missions, of florists, and of France; secondary patroness of the Apostleship of Prayer.

Friday, Oct. 2nd: The Holy Guardian Angels; observed in Spain since the 16th century; blessed spirits who are appointed by God to be protectors and defenders of human beings; each individual has a Guardian Angel who watches over him during the whole course of his/her life.
