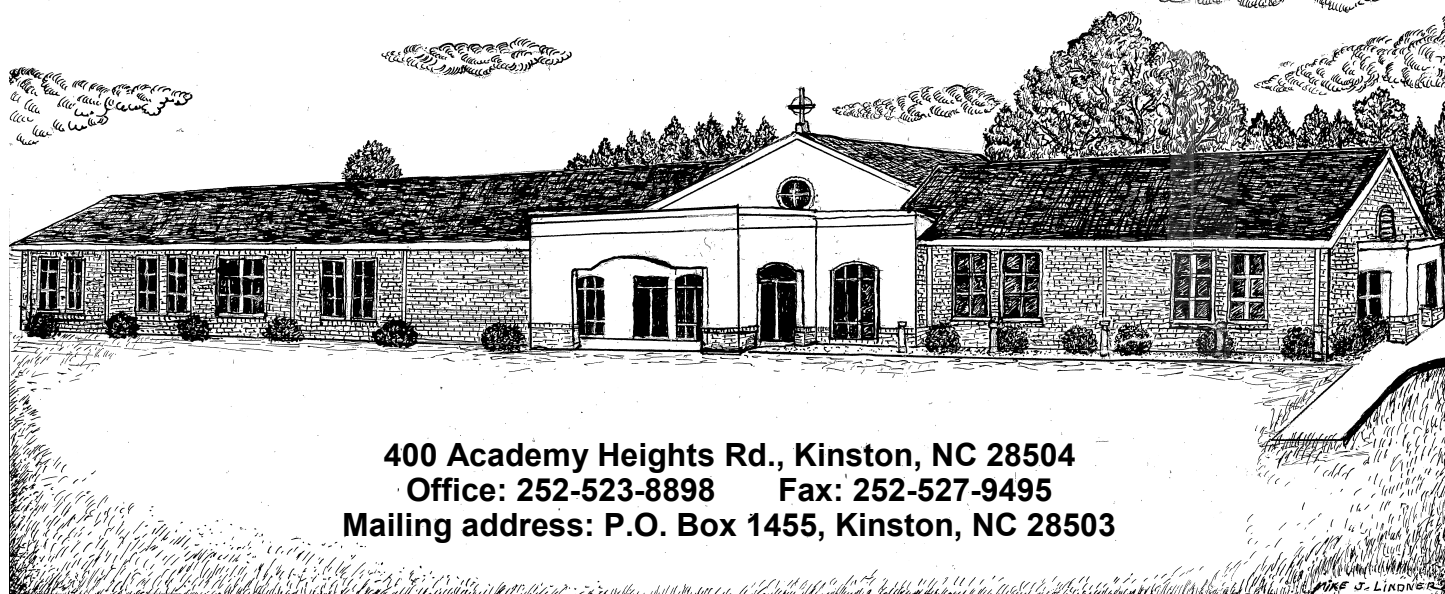

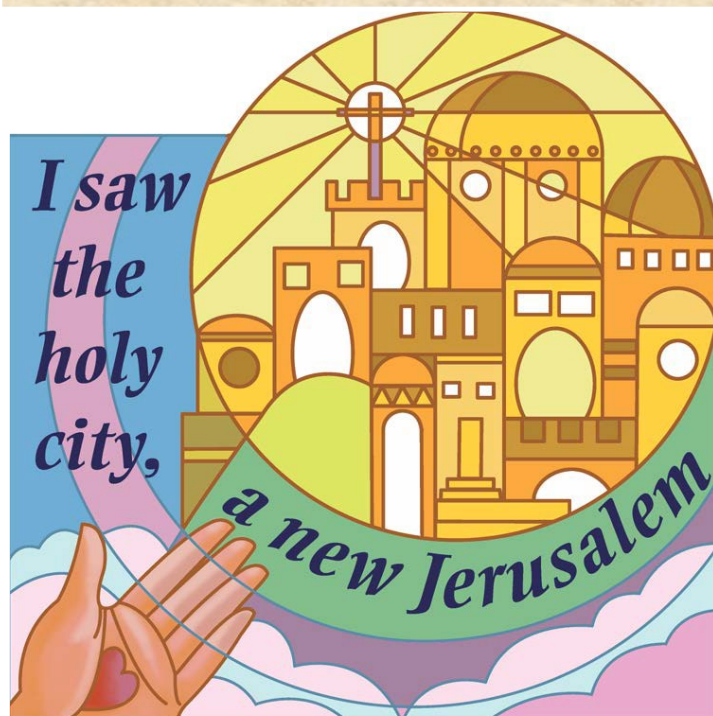

Helpful tips:

1. Always carry identification if you are stopped by the police.
2. If you receive a traffic ticket, be sure to pay it before the day of court or pay an attorney to pay on your behalf on the day of court.
3. Make sure everything in your car is in working order, especially the license plate lights, brake lights and turn signals.
4. Do not open the door for strangers, even if they are from ICE, or if they say they have a piece of paper for you. Tell them to put it under the door or leave it outside.
5. Please never drive drunk, if you do and you are stopped you are certain to be deported.

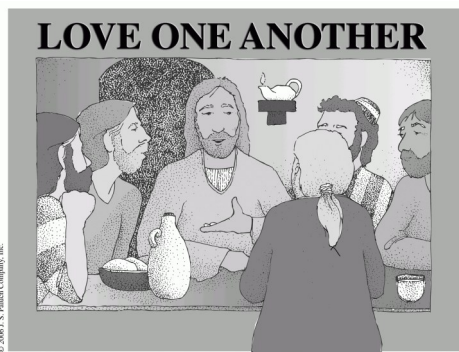

Saints of the Week

Tuesday, May 20th: Saint Bernardine of Siena, Priest; died 1444 at age 64; famous reformer and eloquent preacher who travelled throughout Italy; encouraged devotion to the Holy Name of Jesus; known for his use of the monogram, HIS (an abbreviation of the Greek name for Jesus); patron of advertisers and advertising; invoked against hoarseness.

Wednesday, May 21st: Saint Christopher Magallanes, Priest and Companions, Martyrs; were either shot or hanged (1915-1937) for their association with the *Cristero* uprising which opposed the anti-Catholic Mexican government in the 1920s. The *Cristero* motto was: "Long live Christ the King and the Virgin of Guadalupe!"

Thursday, May 22nd: Saint Rita of Cascia, Religious; was born in 1381 in the town of Roccaporena in Umbria. She lived with a brutal husband and had two sons. After the violent murder of her husband, she urged forgiveness in contrast to the customary vendetta of her day. Becoming an Augustinian nun, she spent some forty years in prayer, contemplation, and service to the sick and poor. Toward the end of her life, she received a wound from a thorn from the crown of thorns. She died in 1457 at age 76. She is the patron saint of those in desperate situations.
