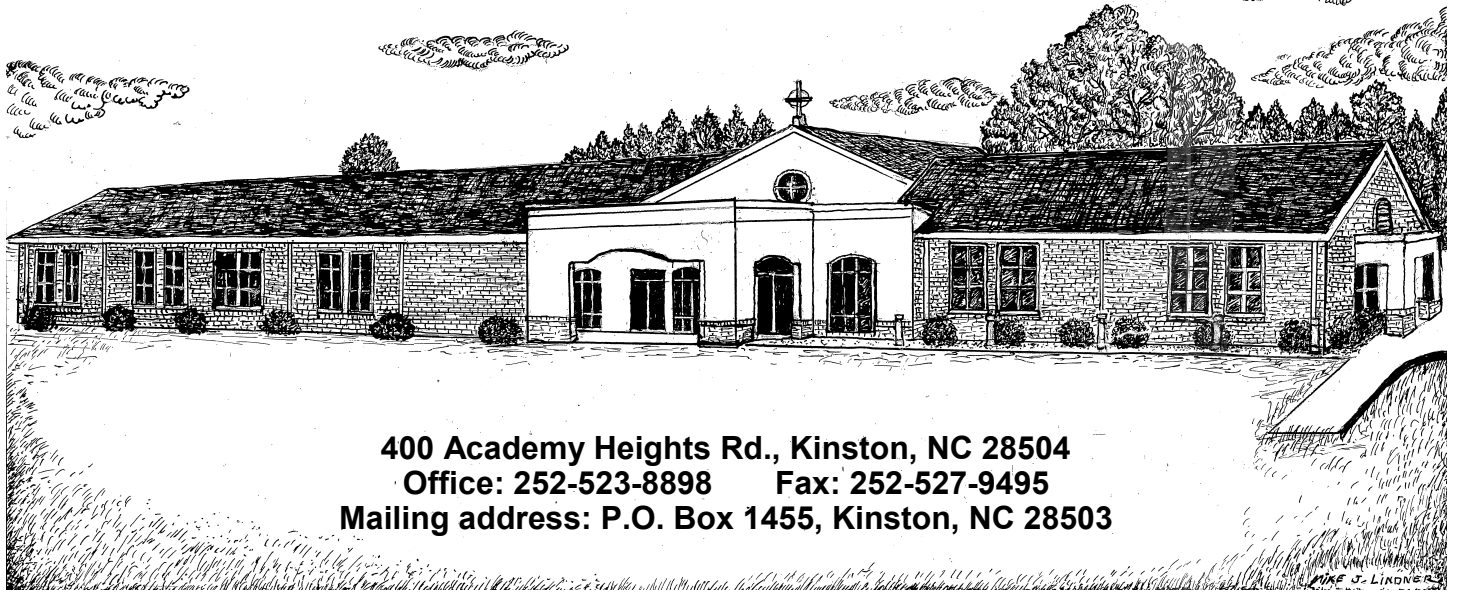

2. If you receive a traffic ticket, be sure to pay it before the day of court or pay an attorney to pay on your behalf on the day of court.
3. Make sure everything in your car is in working order, especially the license plate lights, brake lights and turn signals.
4. Do not open the door for strangers, even if they are from ICE, or if they say they have a piece of paper for you. Tell them to put it under the door or leave it outside.
5. Please never drive drunk, if you do and you are stopped you are certain to be deported.

5. Por favor NUNCA, maneje tomado, si lo hace y lo paran es deportación segura.

## Saints of the Week

**Monday, July 6th:** Saint Maria Goretti, Virgin, Martyr; died 1902 at age twelve; born near Ancona; she was stabbed to death, preferring to die than to be raped; with her mother present, she was canonized in 1950 before the largest crowd ever assembled in Rome for a canonization; patroness of teenage girls.

**Thursday, July 9th:** Saint Augustine Zhao Rong, Priest, and Companions, Martyrs; the 120 martyrs honored today died between 1648 and 1930. Most of them (eighty-seven) were born in China and were children, parents, catechists, or laborers, ranging from nine years of age to seventy-two. This group included four Chinese priests. The thirty-three foreign-born martyrs were mostly priests or women religious, especially from the Order of Preachers (including St. Francis Capillas, who died January 15, 1648, proto-martyr of China), the Paris Foreign Mission Society, the Friars Minor, Jesuits, Salesians, and Franciscan Missionaries of Mary. Augustine Zhao Rong was a Chinese soldier who accompanied the prisoner Bishop John Gabriel Yaurin Dufresse (Paris Mission Society) to his martyrdom in Beijing. Moved by the bishop's courage, Augustine sought baptism and not long after was ordained a diocesan priest. He was martyred in 1815. Beatified in groups at various times, these 120 martyrs were canonized October 1, 2000 by Pope John Paul II.

**Saturday, July 11th:** Saint Benedict, Abbot; died 547 at age 67; wrote famous monastic Rule noted for its wisdom and moderation and need for obedience; "Let all follow the Rule as their guide in everything, and let no one rashly depart from it"; founded twelve monasteries including Monte Cassino; Benedictines today number some 7,500 religious; considered the "Patriarch of Western Monasticism"; a patron of Europe.

**July 6th:** Althea Gibson becomes 1st African-American to win a championship at Wimbledon - 1957

**July 8th:** Lawrence E. Lucas, author, "Black Priest White Church" born NYC - 1933

Venus Williams wins the Wimbledon Women's Singles Championship for the second time in a row - 2001

**July 9th:** Congress ratifies the 14th Amendment, thereby granting U.S. citizenship to African-Americans - 1868

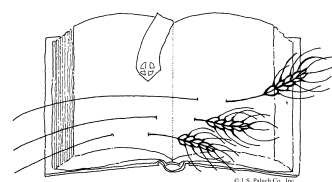
If you would like a Mass for a quinceañera or a wedding, please talk directly to Fr. Joe. There is a form that has to be fill out at the office.
