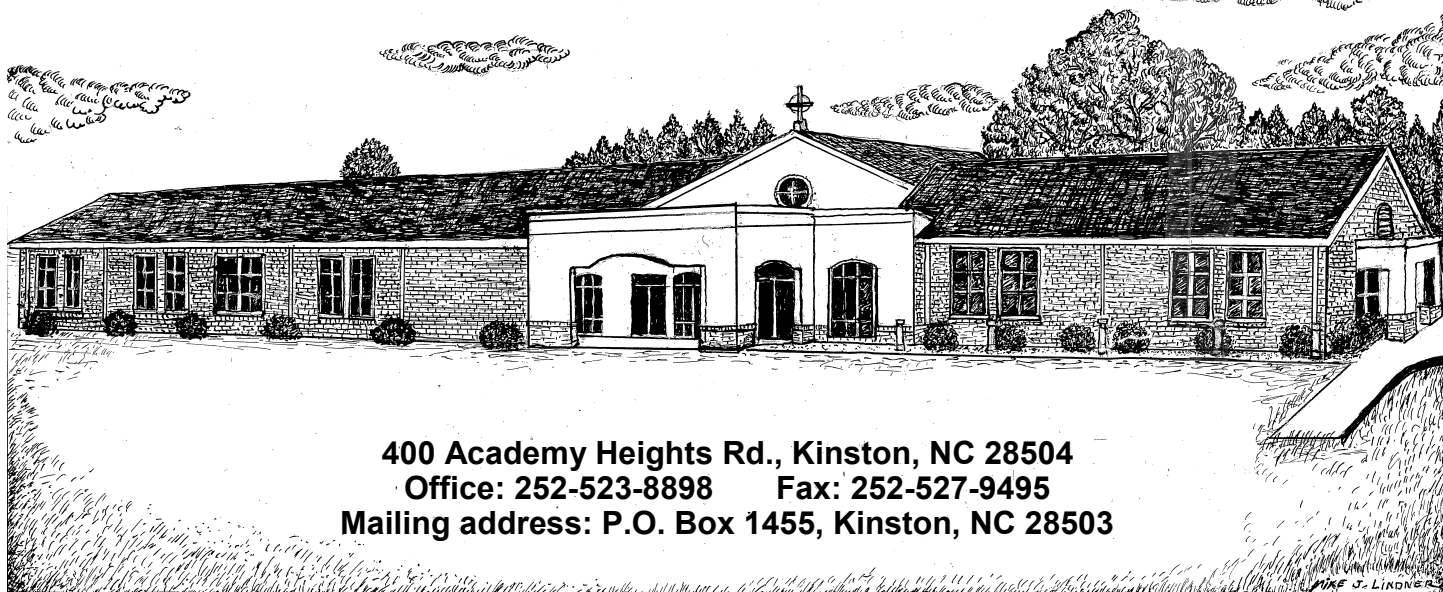

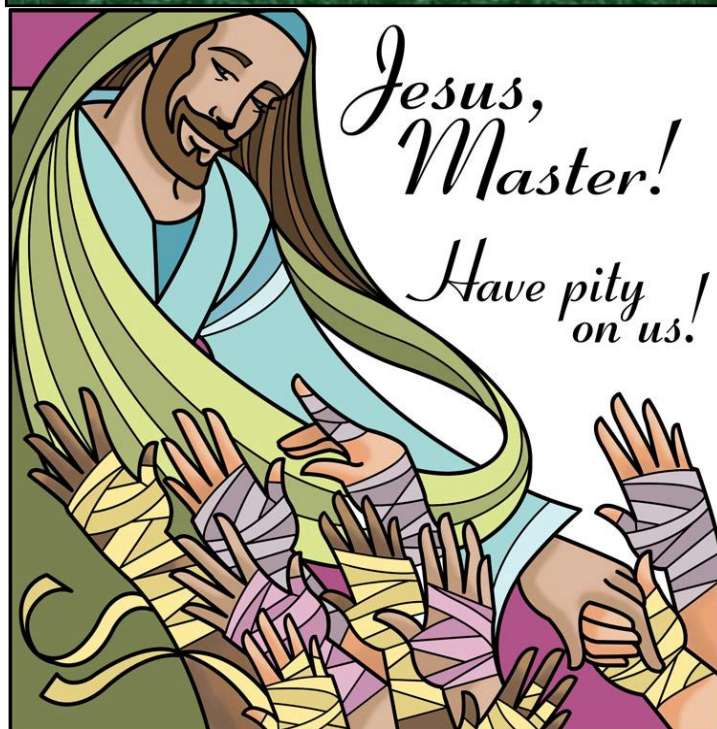

4. Do not open the door for strangers, even if they are from ICE, or if they say they have a piece of paper for you. Tell them to put it under the door or leave it outside.
5. Please never drive drunk, if you do and you are stopped you are certain to be deported.

5. Por favor NUNCA, maneje tomado, si lo hace y lo paran es deportación segura.

Saints of the Week

Tuesday, Oct. 14th: Saint Callistus I, Pope, Martyr; died 222; incurred the ore of Tertullian an St. Hippolytus over *lapsi* controversy; organized the first official Christian cemetery in Rome and instituted Ember Day fasts.

Wednesday, Oct. 15th: Saint Teresa of Jesus, Virgin, Doctor of the Church; died in 1582 at Alba at age 67; Spanish mystic who, with St. John of the Cross (14 Dec.), founded the reformed (Discalced) Carmelite friars and nuns, for which she had to endure great trials; authored Way of Perfection, Interior Castle, and an autobiography; first woman declared “Doctor of the Church” (1970); patroness of Spain.

Thursday, Oct. 16th: (1)Saint Hedwig, Religious; died 1243 at age 69; born in Bavaria; duchess of Silesia and mother of seven children; peacemaker dedicated to the poor and prisoners; as a widow, retired to a Cistercian convent.

(2)Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque, Virgin; died 17 Oct. 1690 at age 43; French Visitandine mystic who promoted devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, a feast which helped free the Church from the spirit of Jansenism; promoted first Friday devotion.

Friday, Oct. 17th: Saint Ignatius of Antioch, Bishop, Martyr; died century 107 under Trajan in Rome’s amphitheater; from Syria; Apostolic Father known as the second successor of St. Peter in Antioch; wrote seven letters to local communities on church unity and structure, esp., the monoespicopacy; first to use the term “Catholic Church” as a collective designation for Christians; mentioned in the Roman Canon.

Saturday, Oct. 18th: Saint Luke, Evangelist; Luke, died first century; Syrian physician from Antioch and companion of Paul; authored (c. 70-85) Acts of the Apostles and a gospel for Gentile Christians; it speaks of God’s mercy, universal salvation, love of the poor and the marginalized, absolute renunciation, prayer and the Holy Spirit; represented by a winged ox; patron of the medical profession, painters, artist, sculptors, and butchers.
