

### **Helpful tips:**

1. Always carry identification if you are stopped by the police.
2. If you receive a traffic ticket, be sure to pay it before the day of court or pay an attorney to pay on your behalf on the day of court.
3. Make sure everything in your car is in working order, especially the license plate lights, brake lights and turn signals.
4. Do not open the door for strangers, even if they are from ICE, or if they say they have a piece of paper for you. Tell them to put it under the door or leave it outside.
5. Please never drive drunk, if you do and you are stopped you are certain to be deported.

4. No abra la Puerta a desconocidos, aun si es de ICE, o si dicen que tienen un papel para Ud. Dígales que lo pasen por debajo de la puerta o que lo dejen afuera.
5. Por favor NUNCA, maneje tomado, si lo hace y lo paran es deportación segura.

## Saints of the Week

**Monday, October 6th:** (1)Saint Bruno, Priest; died 1101 in Calabria; celebrated teacher at Reims and close advisor to his former pupil, Pope Urban II (1088-1099); founded (1084), near Grenoble, La Grande Chartreuse (or Charterhouse), the mother house of the Carthusians, who today number around 320 religious; sought "to seek God assiduously, to find God promptly, and to possess God fully"; their motto: "While the world changes, the Cross stands firm".

(2) Blessed Marie Rose Durocher, Virgin; died 1849 at age thirty-eight; born in St.-Antoine, Québec; began the first Canadian parish sodality for young women; founded the Sisters of the Holy Names of Jesus and Mary for Christian Education.

**Tuesday, October 7th:** Our Lady of the Rosary; this memorial, established by Pope St. Pius V (30 Apr.) in thanksgiving for the victory at Lepanto, 7 Oct. 1571, recalls the rosary and its meditation on the mysteries of Christ and our salvation.

**Thursday, October 9th:** (1)Saint Denis, Bishop and Companions, Martyrs; Denis died 258 at age 22; first bishop of Paris; martyred with the presbyter, Eleutherius, and the deacon, Rusticus, on Montmartre (or "mount of martyrs"); patron of Paris and of France.

(2)Saint John Leonardi, Priest; died 1609 at age 68 in Rome; from Lucca; founded (1574) the Congregation of Clerics Regular of the Mother of God, today numbering about ninety members; in 1579 he formed the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine, and published a compendium of Christian doctrine in use until the 19th century; cofounded with St. Philip Neri (26 May) at Rome the Collegio Urbano which, under the direction of the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples, trains priests for the foreign missions.

**Saturday, October 11th:** Saint John XXIII, Pope; born of a farming family in Sotto il Monte in northern Italy in 1881, Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli was ordained a priest in 1904. After serving in World War I as a stretcher-bearer, he was later made national director of the Society for the Propagation of the Faith. In 1925 he became a papal diplomat, serving in Bulgaria, Turkey, and in France. With the help of Germany's ambassador to Turkey, Roncalli helped save an estimated 24,000 Jewish people during World War II. Named a cardinal and appointed patriarch of Venice in 1953 by Pope Pius XII, he was elected pope in 1958 at age seventy-eight. He convoked (1959) the Second Vatican Council (1962-1965). "Good Pope John" died of stomach cancer 3 June 1963 at age 82. His feast day, 11 October, recalls the day of the first session of the Second Vatican Council (1962). Declared a Blessed in 2000, he was canonized, together with Pope John Paul II, by Pope Francis on 27 April 2014.

### Ladrillos Conmemorativos



Si le gustaría tener un ladrillo con el nombre de su familiar fallecido en nuestro jardín, favor de llamar a la oficina.
