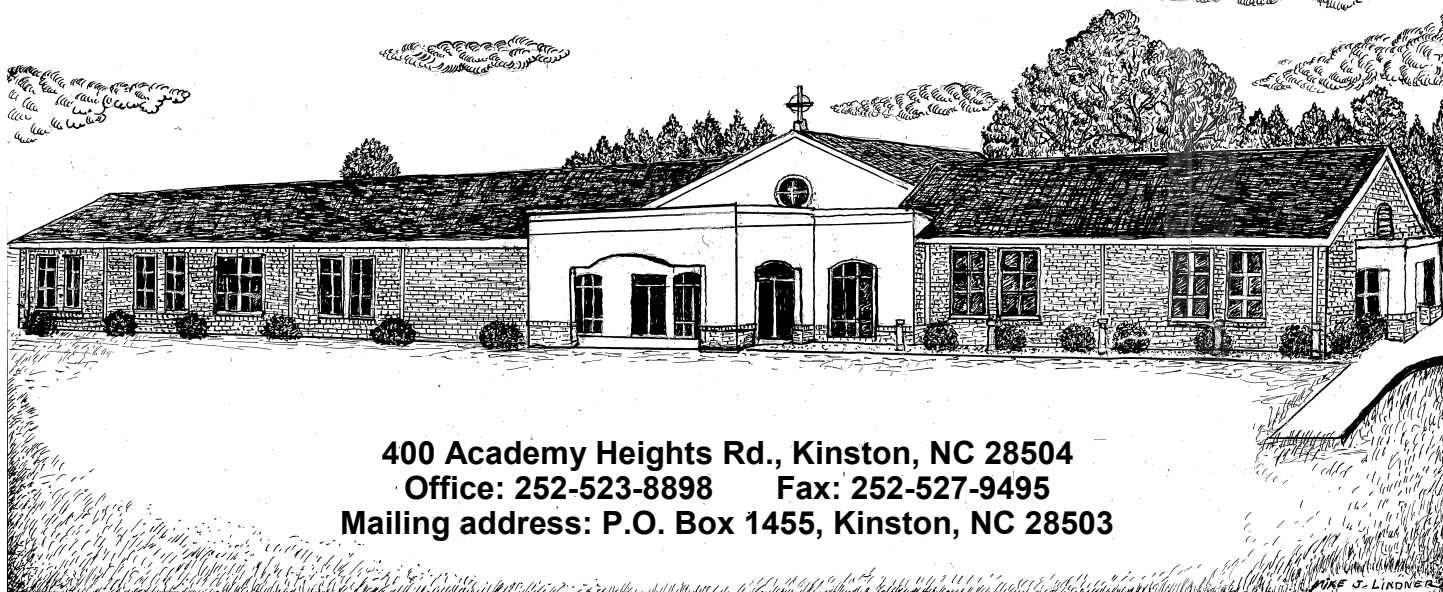

3. Make sure everything in your car is in working order, especially the license plate lights, brake lights and turn signals.
4. Do not open the door for strangers, even if they are from ICE, or if they say they have a piece of paper for you. Tell them to put it under the door or leave it outside.
5. Please never drive drunk, if you do and you are stopped you are certain to be deported.

4. No abra la Puerta a desconocidos, aun si es de ICE, o si dicen que tienen un papel para Ud. Dígales que lo pasen por debajo de la puerta o que lo dejen afuera.
5. Por favor NUNCA, maneje tomado, si lo hace y lo paran es deportación segura.

Saints of the Week

Monday, August 4th: Saint John Vianney, Priest; died 1859 at age 73; universally known as the “Curé of Ars”; compassionate spiritual counselor who spent usually no less than eleven hours every day in the confessional in the winter, sixteen in the summer; patron of priests and the parish clergy.

Tuesday, August 5th: The Dedication of the Basilica of Saint Mary Major; following the declaration of Mary as Teotokos (“God-bearer”) by the Council of Ephesus in 431, Pope Sixtus III erected in Rome this oldest basilica in the West dedicated to the Mother of God.

Thursday, August 7th: Saint Sixtus II, Pope, and Companions, Martyrs; were arrested on 6 Aug. 258 while celebrating the Eucharist in the cemetery of Callistus; by order of Valerian, they were decapitated that same day.

Friday, August 8th: Saint Dominic, Priest; died 6 August 1221 at age 51; born in Caleruega, Spain; founded the Order of Preachers (the Dominicans), today numbering some 6,550 religious; an elective, fraternal form of community life devoted to contemplation, study, and preaching; sought to bring Albigensians back into the Church through preaching and living evangelical poverty; canonized in 1234.

Saturday, August 9th: Saint Teresa Benedicta of the Cross, Virgin, Martyr; was born with the name Edith Stein in Breslau, Germany (now Wroclaw, Poland) in 1891 of Jewish parents. Died at age 51. She studied philosophy under Husserl, the leading phenomenologist of his day. Inspired by the writings of St. Teresa of Avila, she was baptized 1 January 1922. She taught in various schools from 1923-1933 until forced to resign due to anti-Semitic legislation. In 1933, she entered the Discalced Carmelite convent in Cologne where she received the name Teresa Benedicta of the Cross. At the end of 1939, she moved to the convent at Echt, Holland, on account of the Nazi persecution of Jews, but in 1942, during the German occupation of Holland, she was arrested, transported to Poland, and killed (9 August) at the Nazi concentration camp at Auschwitz. Along with St. Catherine of Siena (29 April) and St. Bridget of Sweden (23 July), she was declared co-patroness of Europe by Pope John Paul II.

Mass Petitions

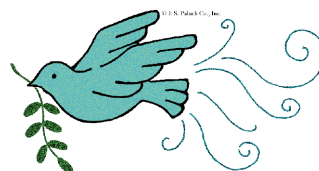
If you would like a Mass for a quinceañera or a wedding, please talk directly to Fr. Joe. There is a form that has to be fill out at the office.
