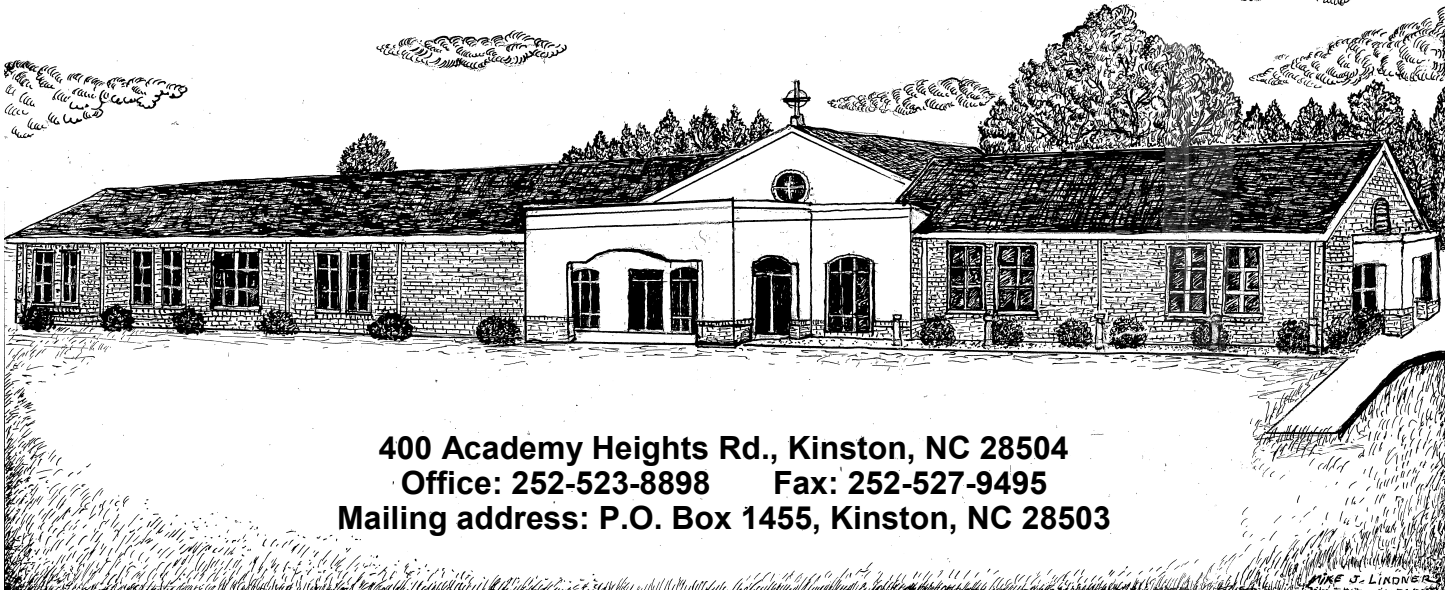

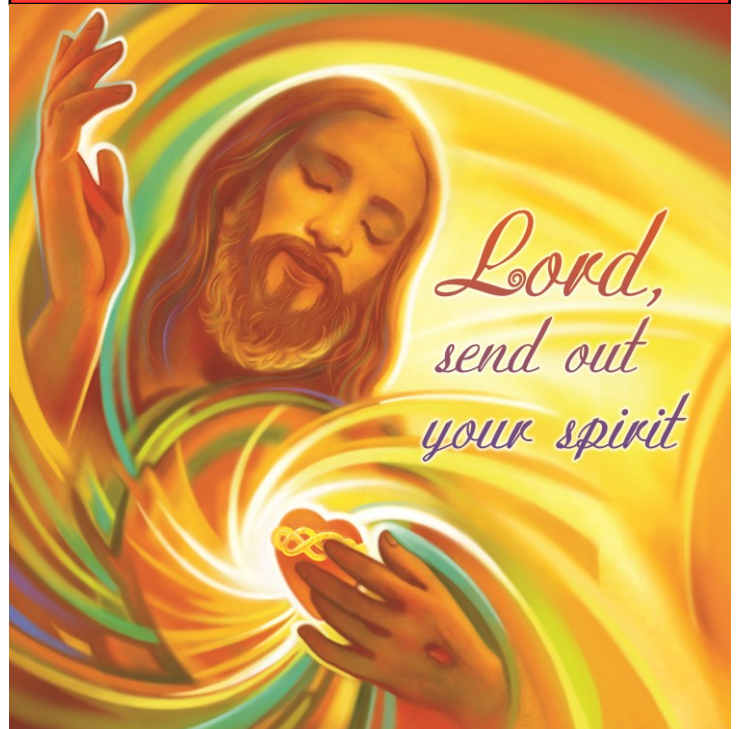

Helpful tips:

3. Make sure everything in your car is in working order, especially the license plate lights, brake lights and turn signals.
4. Do not open the door for strangers, even if they are from ICE, or if they say they have a piece of paper for you. Tell them to put it under the door or leave it outside.
5. Please never drive drunk, if you do and you are stopped you are certain to be deported.

4. No abra la Puerta a desconocidos, aun si es de ICE, o si dicen que tienen un papel para Ud. Dígales que lo pasen por debajo de la puerta o que lo dejen afuera.
5. Por favor NUNCA, maneje tomado, si lo hace y lo paran es deportación segura.

Saints of the Week

Monday, May 25th: The Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church.

Tuesday, May 26th: Saint Philip Neri, Priest; died 1595 at age 80; founded (1575) the Congregation of Priests of the Oratory, today numbering about 570 members, to promote holiness of priestly life and foster effective preaching; noted for his joyful and simple spirit, and his use of short, wise maxims; known as the “Apostle of Rome” and “Reformer of the Eternal City”.

Wednesday, May 27th: Saint Augustine of Canterbury, Bishop; died 26 May 604 at age 70; monk of Mt. Coelius in Rome; sent with forty other monks by Pope Gregory I to England; baptized Ethelbert, king of Kent; ordained a bishop in 597; established the Sees of Canterbury, London, and Rochester; in 601, received the pallium as Primate of England.

Friday, May 29th: Saint Paul VI, Pope; (Giovanni Battista Montini) was born 26 September 1897 in Concesio, Italy. Soon after his ordination in 1920, he began his service to Popes Pius XI and Pius XII. During World War II, he worked to find shelter for persecuted Jews and refugees. Appointed Archbishop of Milan (1954), he worked with great care for the diocese. Four years later, he was created a Cardinal by Pope St. John XXIII, and, following his death, was elected to the See of Peter on 21 June 1963. Immediately continuing the work begun by his predecessors, he brought the Second Vatican Council to its completion and began many initiatives that showed his solicitude for the Church and the contemporary world. He exercised his Supreme Magisterium favoring peace, promoting the progress of peoples, the inculturation of the faith, ecumenism, and liturgical reform. By his authority he promulgated the Calendar, the Missal, the Liturgy of the Hours, the Pontifical, and nearly all the Ritual for the Roman Rite. He died at Castel Gandolfo on 6 August 1978.
