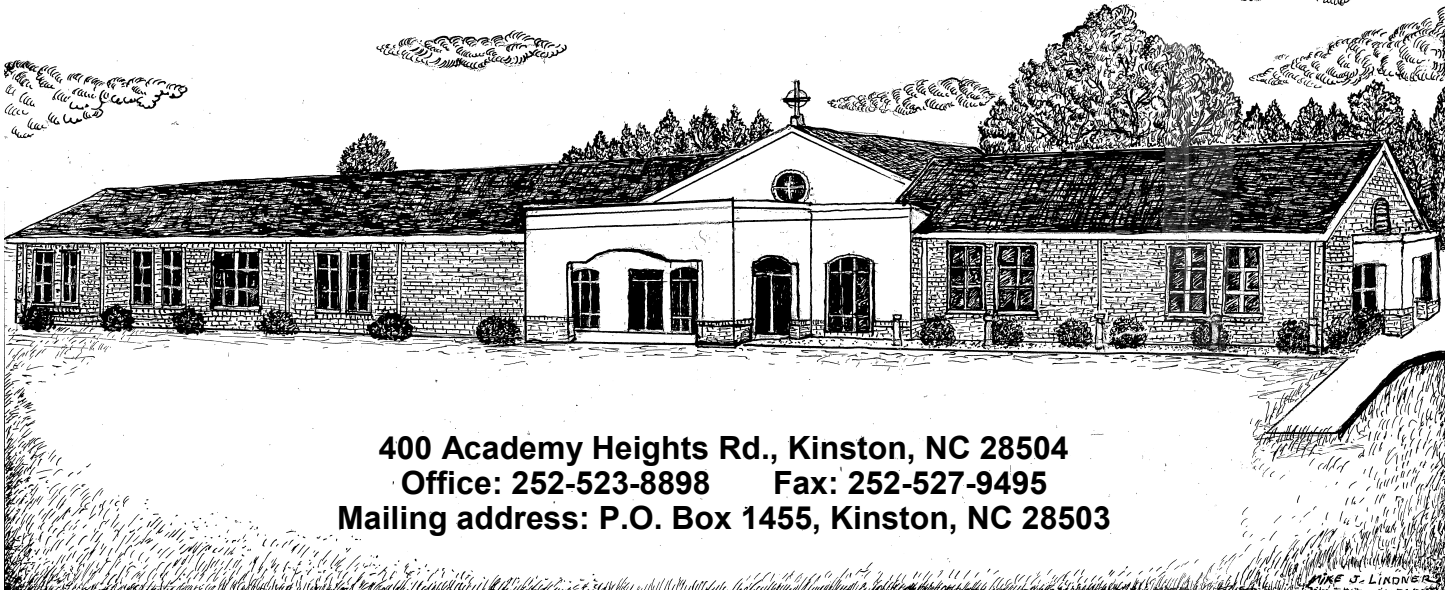

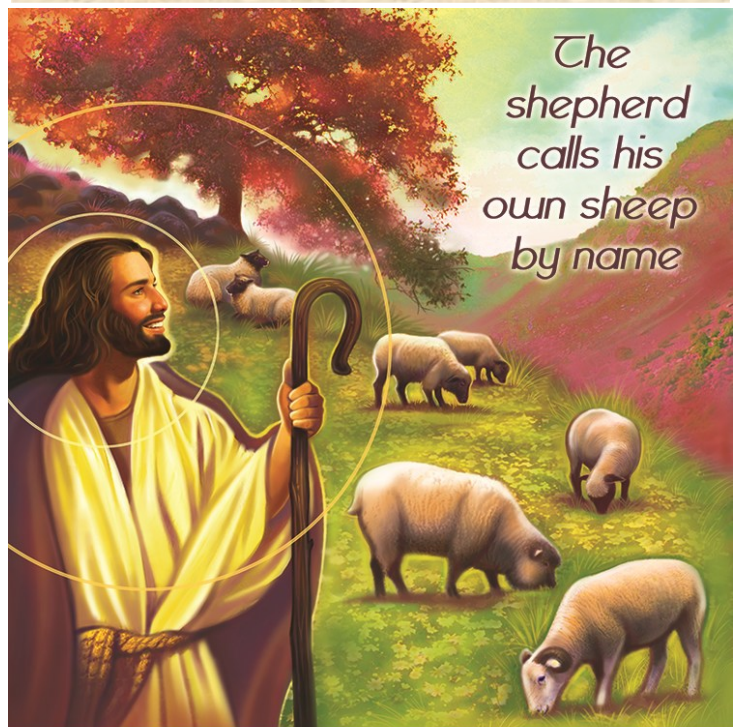

## April 26, 2026 Fourth Sunday of Easter

### Monthly Intention

#### April 2026: For priests in crisis

Let us pray for priests going through moments of crisis in their vocation, that they may find the accompaniment they need and that communities may support them with understanding and prayer.

Christmas was God *with us*.

Easter was God *for us*.

Pentecost is God *in us*.

### Helpful tips:

1. Always carry identification if you are stopped by the police.
2. If you receive a traffic ticket, be sure to pay it before the day of court or pay an attorney to pay on your behalf on the day of court.
3. Make sure everything in your car is in working order, especially the license plate lights, brake lights and turn signals.
4. Do not open the door for strangers, even if they are from ICE, or if they say they have a piece of paper for you. Tell them to put it under the door or leave it outside.
5. Please never drive drunk, if you do and you are stopped you are certain to be deported.

### Consejos útiles:

1. Mantener siempre un documento de identificación si es parado por la policía.
2. Si recibe un ticket de tráfico, asegúrese de pagarlo antes del día de la corte, o pague a un abogado para que ellos lo paguen en su nombre el día de la corte.
3. Asegúrese que en su carro todo funcione bien especialmente las luces de la placa del carro, las del freno y las direccionales.
4. No abra la Puerta a desconocidos, aun si es de ICE, o si dicen que tienen un papel para Ud. Dígalos que lo pasen por debajo de la puerta o que lo dejen afuera.
5. Por favor NUNCA, maneje tomado, si lo hace y lo paran es deportación segura.

Second collections are optional. Parishioners are given this choice at the moment of passing the baskets.

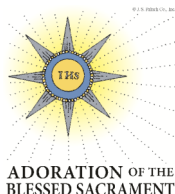
## Segunda Colecta del Siguiete Domingo

## Saints of the Week

**Tuesday, April 28th: (1)** Saint Peter Chanel, Priest, Martyr; died 1841 at age 38; French Marist missionary on the Pacific islands of Wallis and Futuna where he was martyred; destroyed cult of evil spirits; protomartyr and patron of Oceania.

**(2)** Saint Louis Grignion de Montfort, Priest; died 1716 at age 43; from Brittany; studied at Saint Sulpice; hospital chaplain and founder of the Congregation of the Daughters of Wisdom; apostolic missionary whose preaching led to a spiritual revival in his native Brittany; established numerous confraternities for the recitation of the rosary; founded (1705) the Missionaries of the Company of Mary, today numbering about 930 religious. Chief work: *True Devotion to the Blessed Virgin*.

**Wednesday, April 29th:** Saint Catherine of Siena, Virgin, Doctor of the Church; died 1380 at age 33; Sister of the Dominican Order (tertiary), mystic, and author (*The Dialogue*); peacemaker within the Church and renewer of religious life; worked toward ending the Avignon papacy under Gregory XI (1377); declared doctor of the Church in 1970; patroness of Italy and, together with St. Bridget of Sweden (23 July) and St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross [Edith Stein] (9 August), co-patroness of Europe.

**Thursday, April 30th:** Saint Pius V, Pope; died 1 May 1572; who implemented the reforms of the Council of Trent; promulgated the Roman Catechism, the Roman Missal, and the Roman Breviary whose 1962 editions may be used according to the 2007 *motu proprio*, *Summorum Pontificum*, of Pope Benedict XVI, later modified, 16 July 2021, by Pope Francis in his *motu proprio*, *Traditionis custodes*; canonized 22 May 1712.

**Friday, May 1st:** St. Joseph the Worker.

**Saturday, May 2nd:** Saint Athanasius, Bishop, Doctor of the Church; died 373; forty-five years the bishop of Alexandria; champion of Nicea (325); prolific polemicist against the Arians who exiled him five times; one of the four great doctors of the Eastern Church; wrote *On the Incarnation*, the *Discourse Against the Arians*, and the *Life of Antony* (17 Jan.); known as the "Doctor of the Incarnation."

### Mother's Day Cards

### May is the Month of the Blessed Virgin Mary

As the Mother of God, the Virgin Mary has a unique position among the saints, indeed, among all creatures. She is exalted, yet still one of us.

Redeemed by reason of the merits of her Son and united to Him by a close and indissoluble tie, she is endowed with the high office and dignity of being the Mother of the Son of God, by which account she is also the beloved daughter of the Father and the temple of the Holy Spirit. Because of this gift of sublime grace she far surpasses all creatures, both in heaven and on earth. At the same time, however, because she belongs to the offspring of Adam she is one with all those who are to be saved. (Lumen Gentium, no. 53)

Mary embraces God's will and freely chooses to cooperate with God's grace, thereby fulfilling a crucial role in God's plan of salvation. Throughout the centuries, the Church has turned to the Blessed Virgin in order to come closer to Christ. Many forms of piety toward the Mother of God developed that help bring us closer to her Son. In these devotions to Mary, "while the Mother is honored, the Son, through whom all things have their being and in whom it has pleased the Father that all fullness should dwell, is rightly known, loved and glorified and . . . all His commands are observed." The Church honors her as the Mother of God, looks to her as a model of perfect discipleship, and asks for her prayers to God on our behalf.
