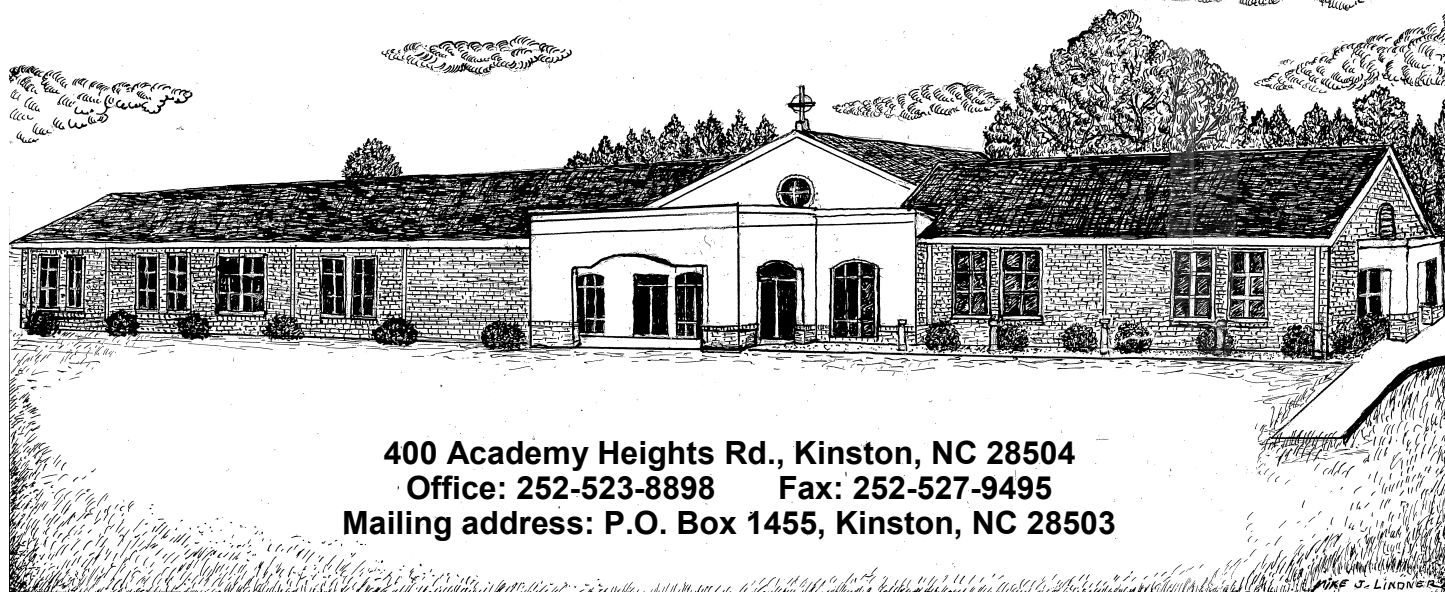

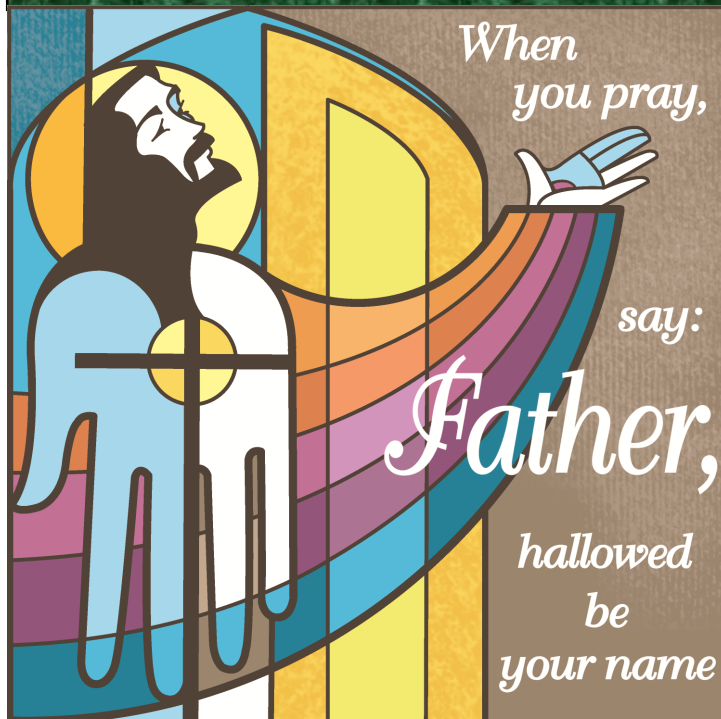

Helpful tips:

1. Always carry identification if you are stopped by the police.
2. If you receive a traffic ticket, be sure to pay it before the day of court or pay an attorney to pay on your behalf on the day of court.
3. Make sure everything in your car is in working order, especially the license plate lights, brake lights and turn signals.
4. Do not open the door for strangers, even if they are from ICE, or if they say they have a piece of paper for you. Tell them to put it under the door or leave it outside.
5. Please never drive drunk, if you do and you are stopped you are certain to be deported.

Saints of the Week

Tuesday, July 29th: Saint Martha; sister of Mary and Lazarus; model of hospitality and faithful disciple; confessed her faith in Jesus as the Son of God; patroness of housewives, waiters, and waitresses.

Wednesday, July 30th: Saint Peter Chrysologus; Bishop, Doctor of the Church; died in 450 at age 44, was called “Chrysologus”, meaning “of golden speech” for his exceptional preaching ability; 170 homilies are extant; bishop of Ravenna.

Thursday, July 31st: Saint Ignatius of Loyola, Priest; died 1556; soldier. Founded the *Compañía de Jesús* (Latin: *Societas Iesu* [S.J.]); approved by Pope Paul III in 1540; authored the *Spiritual Exercises*; founded the Roman College; at his death, the Society numbered 1,000 members in seventy-six houses in twelve provinces, including Brazil, Japan and India; today numbers some 15,300 members; devoted *ad maiorem Dei gloriam*; patron saint of retreatants and soldiers.

Friday, August 1st: Saint Alphonsus Liguori, Bishop, Doctor of the Church; died 1787 at age 91; lawyer; founded (1732) the Redemptorists, today numbering some 5,400 members; opposed Jansenism, stressing Christ’s love and Mary’s help; bishop of Saint’ Agata dei Goti; master of moral theology; patron of confessors and of moral theologians.

Saturday, August 2nd: (1) Saint Eusebius of Vercelli, Bishop; died 371 at age 88; considered the founder of the canons regular in the West; defender of St. Athanasius; exiled to Palestine by Constantius; with St. Hilary (13 Jan.), an opponent of Arianism.

(2) Saint Peter Julian Eymard, Priest; died 1 August 1868 at age 57; born at La Mure d’Isère, France, 4 Feb. 1811; founded (1856) the Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament, today numbering some 900 members, devoted to the worship and apostolate of the Eucharist as the center of the life of the Church and society; in 1858 founded the Servants of the Blessed Sacrament, a contemplative women’s community; influenced the founding of the Eucharistic Fraternity for the laity, the Association of Priest Adorers, and international Eucharistic congresses.

African American History & Heritage

July 28th: Silent March Parade, approximately 10,000 African-Americans marched down Fifth Avenue in NYC in silent protest against racial oppression– 1917.

July 30th: Buddy Guy, Blues guitarist/singer, born 1936 Letchworth, LA

July 31st: Patrick F. Healy, SJ inaugurated as President of Georgetown University, Washington, DC - 1874
