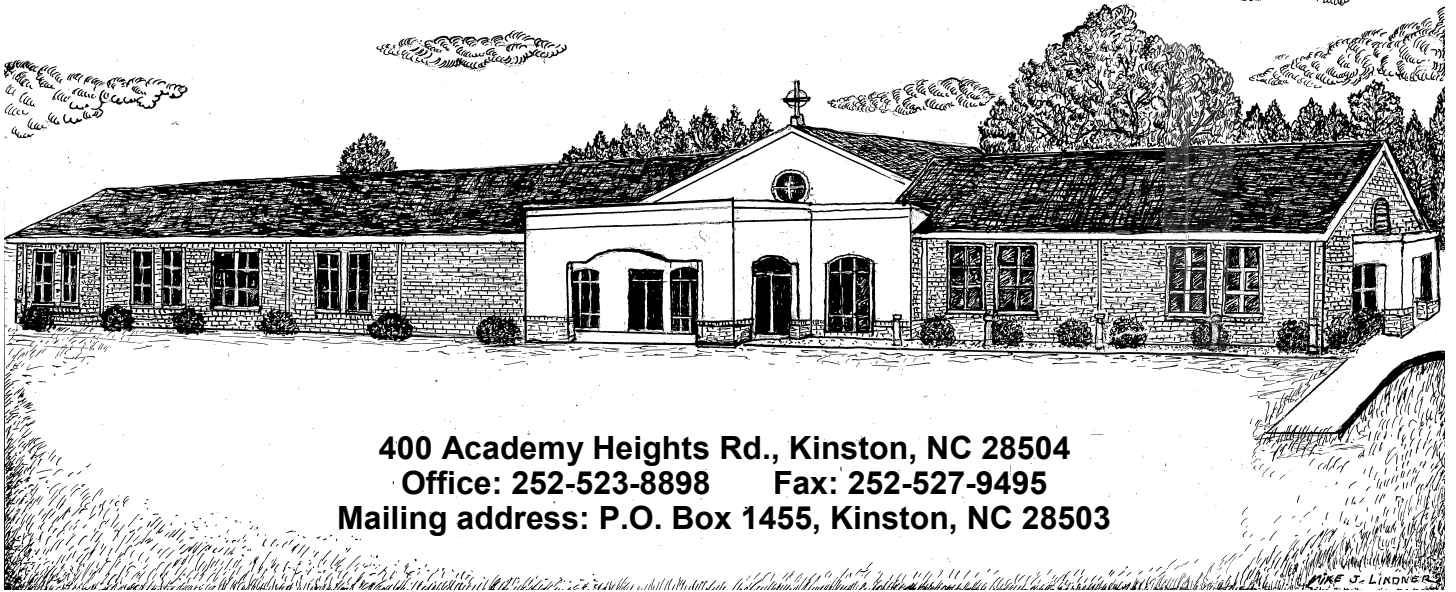

Helpful tips:

1. Always carry identification if you are stopped by the police.
2. If you receive a traffic ticket, be sure to pay it before the day of court or pay an attorney to pay on your behalf on the day of court.
3. Make sure everything in your car is in working order, especially the license plate lights, brake lights and turn signals.
4. Do not open the door for strangers, even if they are from ICE, or if they say they have a piece of paper for you. Tell them to put it under the door or leave it outside.
5. Please never drive drunk, if you do and you are stopped you are certain to be deported.

Saints of the Week

Monday, May 12th: (1) Saints Nereus and Achilleus, Martyrs; died end of 1st century; Praetorian soldiers who converted to Christianity; beheaded during the reign of Trajan (98-117) on the island of Terracina.

(2) Saint Pancras, Martyr; died 304 at age 14; a Syrian or Phrygian orphan who came to Rome where he was converted to Christianity; he was beheaded under Diocletian; buried on the Via Aurelia.

Tuesday, May 13th: Our Lady of Fatima; is venerated under this title following apparitions to three shepherd children in Portugal in 1917. The message of Fatima includes a call to conversion of heart, repentance from sin, and prayer, especially the Rosary.

Wednesday, May 14th: Saint Matthias, apostle; died 1st century; chosen to replace Judas; qualified because he witnessed Jesus' ministry and resurrection; said to have suffered martyrdom either at Colchis (modern day Georgia) or in Jerusalem; mentioned in the Roman Canon.

Thursday, May 15th: Saint Isidore; died 1130 at age 60; layman whose wife, Maria de la Cabeza (Toribia) is also a saint; farm laborer associated with miracles; patron of Madrid, of farmers, and rural communities.



African American History & Heritage

May 12th: Segregated street cars integrated in Louisville, KY, following sit-in staged by a black teenager - 1871.

May 15th: U.S. Congress declares that U.S. citizens who engage in the foreign slave trade are subject to punishment by death - Act of 1820.

May 17th: In Brown v. Board of Education of Topeka, KS the U.S. Supreme Court declares that segregation in schools is unconstitutional - 1954.
