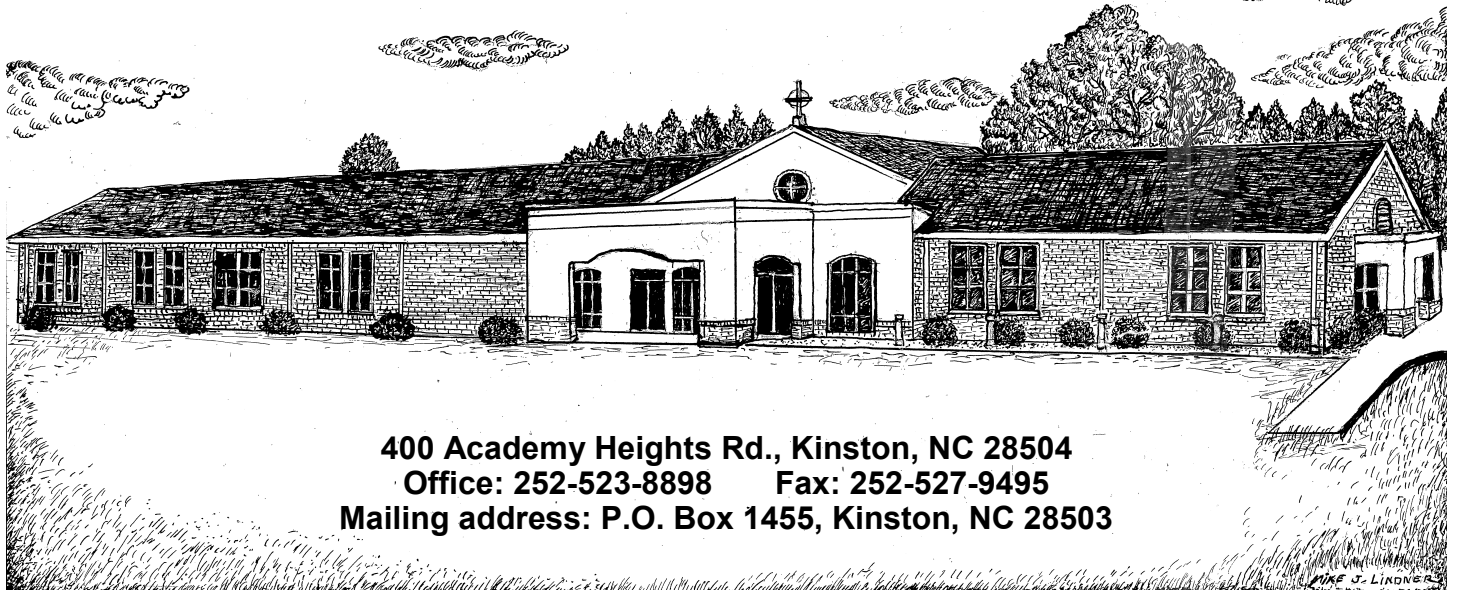

Helpful tips:

1. Always carry identification if you are stopped by the police.
2. If you receive a traffic ticket, be sure to pay it before the day of court or pay an attorney to pay on your behalf on the day of court.
3. Make sure everything in your car is in working order, especially the license plate lights, brake lights and turn signals.
4. Do not open the door for strangers, even if they are from ICE, or if they say they have a piece of paper for you. Tell them to put it under the door or leave it outside.
5. Please never drive drunk, if you do and you are stopped you are certain to be deported.

1. Mantener siempre un documento de identificación si es parado por la policía.

3. Asegúrese que en su carro todo funcione bien especialmente las luces de la placa del carro, las del freno y las direccionales.
4. No abra la Puerta a desconocidos, aun si es de ICE, o si dicen que tienen un papel para Ud. Dígales que lo pasen por debajo de la puerta o que lo dejen afuera.
5. Por favor NUNCA, maneje tomado, si lo hace y lo paran es deportación segura.

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Saints of the Week

Monday, Nov. 17th: Saint Elizabeth of Hungary, Religious; died 1231 at age 23; wife of Louis VI of Thuringia and mother of three; as a widow, she became a Franciscan tertiary, dedicated to the needs of the poor and the sick; canonized only four years after her death; patroness of the Franciscan Third Order and of Catholic charities.

Tuesday, Nov. 18th: (1) The Dedication of the Basilicas of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles; around 330 Constantine built a basilica over the tomb of St. Peter. Reconstruction began in the 14th century and the present basilica of St. Peter was consecrated 18 Nov. 1626 by Pope Urban VIII. The construction of St. Paul's on the Via Ostiense was begun by Valentinian II in 386, taking the place of a smaller church built by Constantine. Destroyed by fire in 1823, the new basilica was consecrated 10 Dec. 1854 by Pope Pius IX who joined in one solemn celebration the dedication of these two basilicas.

(2) Saint Rose Philippine Duchesne, Virgin; died 1852 at age 83 at St. Charles, Missouri; from Grenoble, France; founded the first American house of the Religious of the Sacred Heart; opened the first American free school west of the Mississippi; known for her courage and desire to serve Native Americans, especially, the Potawatomi who called her "the woman who prays always".

Friday, November 21st: The Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary; Today's memorial finds its origins in a 2nd century apocryphal source, the *Protoevangelion* or *Book of James*, and the dedication on 21 Nov. 543 of the Basilica of St. Mary the New in Jerusalem.

Saturday, Nov. 22nd: Saint Cecilia, Virgin, Martyr; died 3rd century; known for her legendary *Passio*, a poem which exalts Christian virginity; honored in Rome since the 5th century; patroness of sacred music because of the song of God in her heart.

African American History & Heritage

Nov. 17th: Capture of George Latimer in Boston led to first of the fugitive slave cases which embittered North and South. Boston abolitionists raised money to purchase Latimer from his slaveholder.— 1842
