

The proposed Lidsing Garden Village development is set to build 2,000+ HOUSES at the far edge of the Borough of Maidstone



This will replace the current green spaces between Maidstone and Medway with a single urban sprawl, aligning exactly to the Maidstone/Medway border with Hempstead and Bredhurst. This will remove a valuable and irreplaceable "green lung" in an area where air pollution is already of considerable concern. Natural habitats will be decimated and rural areas destroyed.

The adjoining land is also subject to further development plans, with Gibraltar Farm, East Hill at Capstone and Gleaming Wood Drive in Lordswood proposals to add many more homes. Maidstone Borough Council will benefit by collecting Council Tax from the new houses but the new residents will use Medway resources funded by Medway residents.
