


Plumbing Installation Guide

For Overflow Systems


Parts List

- ☐ A Bottom Half of Plumbing Bulkhead (with O-ring)
- □ B Top Half of Plumbing Bulkhead
- ☐ C Red Inner Pipe with Spiral Silencer
- □ D Blue Outer Pipe Housing
- ☐ E Blue Strainer
- ☐ F Sump Pipe (with clamp)
- ☐ G Siphon Pipe (with valve)



% Installation Steps

Step 1



Place the top half of the plumbing bulkhead (B) on top of the hole in the tank.

Note: Overflow wall was removed for illustrative purposes. Removal is not necessary for installation.

Step 2



Take the bottom half of the plumbing bulkhead (A) and align it through the hole to the top half (B).

Note: Transparent O-ring is with the bottom half, under the tank.

Step 3



Screw together and tighten the bottom half (A) and top half (B) of the plumbing bulkhead — hand-tight only.


Note: Two people make this step easier as one holds the bottom half while the other secures the top.

Step 4



Place the red inner pipe with spiral silencer (C) into the bulkhead fitting (B). Slide it down until it seats snugly. Twist gently to confirm it's fully inserted — it will protrude slightly above the top.


Step 5



Place the blue outer pipe housing (D) over the top half of the plumbing bulkhead (B). Then, insert the blue strainer (E) on top of the blue pipe housing.



Step 6



Connect all plumbing tubing to the fittings on the bottom half of the plumbing bulkhead (A).

Note: The siphon pipe is normally closed and only opened during water changes. It will drain the tank completely.
