Thoughts from 7 Figure Fiction by T. Taylor on Universal Fantasy:	
Universal Fantasy Relatable:	Why the book is good, what makes a reader feel something and connect with the characters; butterflies in tummy, reactions of lower extremities, tears. Ex: overweight and low self esteem, in a bad relationship, their life is boring, family issues, daddy issues, putting others before their own needs, fixer upper, someone needing healing over an emotional wound, forgiveness of a friend, parent, etc, true love match, fake relationship. BREAKING THE RULES, saving someone, something you love...Basically, any relatable circumstance we ourselves can empathize with
Universal Fantasy Butter:	Where this person fits into their personal world. Ex: all powerful (like a king or prince), part of a new and interesting world and their importance within it, badass, plucky, resourceful, uniquely created to solve a problem
Universal Fantasy Ghee:	Something that makes the character unique: knows a certain skill set, overcoming personal obstacles set out for you by parents or other authority figures, winning as an underdog, powerful in their world, navigating a problem that is 10 times more dramatic/intense/important/life and death than our own similar small life problems; Basically, a Universal Vanilla Fantasy with a different flavor - same problem, different people with different challenges throughout the problem EX: two emotionally people need each other to heal - BUT, they are both widowed, one with kids; opposite world with problems like ours; someone dealing with a regular situation, BUT she has autism difficulties ON TOP of dealing with the problem
Any Universal Fantasy that usually shows up in one genre, but will show up in this one (which is the total opposite genre)	Ex: An age gap romance between two over 40 lovers, a small town romance set in an alien world, a sitcom that takes place in the afterlife instead of the present; Opposite of Fantasy is reality - what UF would happen in reality? Put it into a fantasy novel and then AMP it UP.
