If you are a renter, you must bring a copy of your lease agreement or a current electric bill showing your name and property address. You must also provide your landlord's name and phone number. If you do not obtain your tags on one of the dates listed below, you will be charged an appointment fee of \$10.00 to obtain your tags.
