Lake MUD regular weekly collection dates: Meadowlake Village (Mon/Thurs), Bay River Colony (Mon/Thurs), Highlands Ranch (Tues/Fri), and West Meadows (Tues/Fri) Trash must be out at 7:00am on your service day for collection!!!!

Please use the provided blue Hotchkiss Disposal 96 gallon can for your bagged household trash. On each regularly scheduled service day, we will pick up at the street, all properly packaged household garbage, grass clippings and leaves must be in trash cans (our 96 gal or no larger than 42 gal cans) or bags, not to exceed 7 bags. Tree trimmings and branches cut in lengths not to exceed three (3) feet, securely tied in bundles and weighing not more than fifty (50) pounds. Boxes from new move-ins will be collected at the street on any collection day but they must be broken down. Fifty-five-gallon containers and totter containers of a size larger than 42 gallons other than 96-gallon containers provided by Hotchkiss are not acceptable. Each homeowner is responsible for the safe keeping of the provided HDS trash can. Trash cans lost, stolen, or damaged beyond normal wear and tear will be replaced at the homeowner's expense. Trash cans are not to be removed from the residence upon vacating as they are property of HDS. If your trash can needs repair due to normal wear and tear, please contact us. Items Accepted for heavy trash: washers, dryers, televisions, water heaters, mattresses (queen or smaller) furniture and etc. Refrigerators, freezers, AC units, and other items ONLY if CFC's (freon) has been removed and the item has been tagged as such, in compliance with state and federal laws.

Items NOT Accepted: box springs of any size, king size mattresses, scrap metal, construction materials/debris, concrete, bricks, dirt, batteries, tires, fuels/oils, hazardous waste, wet paint, solvents, tree stumps, limbs larger than 5" or longer than 3-4ft, explosive materials, automobile bodies, any items over 50lbs, etc. If you have questions about an item, please feel free to give our office a call ahead of heavy trash collection at 281-427-6666.
