

HOW TO: BECOME A DELEGATE

What's a Delegate?

Delegates are elected at their caucus to attend the county assembly. At county assembly, they cast their vote to nominate local candidates onto the primary ballot. Any registered Democrat can run to become a delegate! No experience needed.

Step 1: Attend your County Caucus

Your county caucus is where delegates are chosen. You must attend to run for or vote for delegates. **Find out when and where your county caucus is at ColoradoDems.org/caucus/schedule.**

Step 2: Run to Be a Delegate

At caucus, you can run to be a delegate. Democrats in your precinct vote to choose who will serve as delegates. **Learn more at ColoradoDems.org/caucus/delegate.**

Step 3: Hear from Candidates

Candidates will reach out to you to earn your support. You will learn a lot about their values and plans for the office they're running for throughout this process.

Step 4: Attend County Assembly

At county assembly, you will vote for your favorite local candidates, take a preference poll for the U.S. Senate race, Congressional races and sometimes for State House and Senate district races. You will also take a straw poll for the Governor, Treasurer, Secretary of State, and Attorney General races.

Step 5: Run for the next Assembly

At county assembly, you can be elected as a delegate to support your favorite candidates for the State House and Senate District assemblies, Congressional District Assemblies and State Assembly for statewide candidates.
