MINUTES OF ANNUAL MEETING OF LANDOWNERS OF

The INDIAN RIVER FARMS WATER CONTROL DISTRICT held its 106th annual meeting of landowners at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, February 27, 2026 at the office of the District at 7305 4th Street, Vero Beach, Florida.

At 2:00 p.m. the meeting was called to order by Supervisor Will Barker. Present were Supervisors Bobby Lindsey, William Barker, and David E. Gunter, Secretary; David E. Gunter, Jr. Superintendent; David Luethje, LJA Engineering for the District; Paul Amos, Lowndes attorney for the District; landowner David Bass; and various District landowners.

Motion was made by Supervisor Will Barker for Paul Amos to read the Official Notice of the Meeting, Supervisor Bobby Lindsey moves to dispense reading, motion duly seconded by Will Barker.

Supervisor Bobby Lindsey moved to nominate David Bass as Chairman, which motion was duly seconded by David Luethje. Motion unanimously carried and David Bass was appointed as Chairman of the meeting.

Chairman Bass took the gavel and appointed David Gunter as Secretary of the meeting.

Bobby Lindsey made a motion to dispense with reading of the preceding year's minutes, motion duly seconded by Mr. Bass, motion unanimously carried and resolved to accept the minutes as read.

Chairman Bass called on David Gunter to present the Secretary's annual report and such report was given in the form attached to these minutes.

Chairman Bass then called on David Luethje for the engineering consultant firm's report and such report was given in the form attached to these minutes. Motion duly made, put and carried his report was accepted.

Chairman Bass then called for David E. Gunter to give report for the aquatic consultant and such report was given in the form attached to these minutes.

On motion duly made by Will Barker to approve Minutes from last years meeting and all three reports as read, duly seconded by Bobby Lindsey, the motion unanimously carried and Last year's minutes and all three reports were approved as presented.

Chairman Bass asked for nominations to succeed Supervisor Mark Tripson, whose term was expiring. Will Barker nominated Bobby Lindsey to succeed himself for a three-year term, duly seconded by David Luethje. On vote of the landowners present, Bobby Lindsey was elected unanimously to succeed himself for a three-year term.

Chairman Bass called for old business and there being none, then Chairman Bass called for new business. There being no new business, the meeting was adjourned at 2:48 p.m. by Chairman David Bass.
