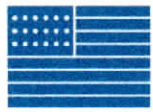
10 MULTI-FATAL FIRES

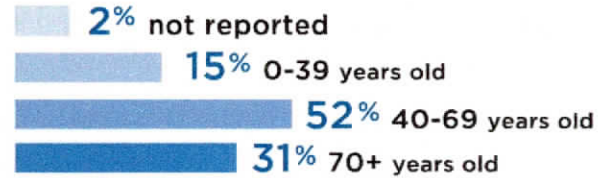
