

CHAIN OF CUSTODY & LAB SHIPPING

QUICK REFERENCE

Non-negative or inconclusive results must be sent into the laboratory for testing.

You will need the three-ply chain of custody form and the Federal Express Shipping Materials.

□ ADVISE THE DONOR THAT AN ADDITIONAL FORM IS REQUIRED.

□ FILL IN THE DONOR INFORMATION -Enter Donor Name, Date of Birth, Donor ID and Gender.

 \Box SEAL CUP - Remove the Seal from the bottom of the control form and affix to the cup. (Affix across the top of the cup to seal both sides).

□ REQUEST THAT THE DONOR SIGN THE FORM – The third section of the form "TO BE COMPLETED BY DONOR"

□ REQUEST THAT THE DONOR DATE AND INITIAL THE SEAL – There is a spot on the seal for the date and donor's initials

□ COMPLETE SECTION 2 – DRUG TEST TO BE PERFORMED – Check only the drug panel that did not produce two lines. Checking all the boxes will slow the result down.

□ COMPLETE COLLECTOR CERTIFICATION - Sign the form, provide your name, date collected, time collected, temperature findings and indicate that the specimen was released to Federal Express.

□ PLACE THE SPECIMEN IN THE SMALL BIOHAZARD BAG – Place the specimen in the back portion of the bag that has the absorbent material.

□ SEPARATE THE CHAIN OF CUSTODY FORM – TOP COPY IN BAG – Fold the top copy and place in the front portion of the biohazard bag & Seal the bag. Please a copy in the driver file.

□ PLACE IN FED/EX CLINICAL PACK – Place the biohazard bag with the chain of custody into the Federal Express Clinical Pak shipping bag.

 \Box APPLY THE FEDERAL EXPRESS LABEL TO THE OUTSIDE OF THE SHIPPING BAG.

 \Box CALL 1-800-GO-FEDEX to schedule a pickup or drop in your local Federal Express Drop Box.

 \Box FAX A COPY OF THE CHAIN OF CUSTODY FORM TO 888.977.8834
