14-A.D. 1525 - William Tyndale:



William Tyndale produced the first English Bible

translation, of the New Testament from Greek into-YES—INTO English, while fleeing for his life, while doing so, and finally burned so you and I could have **a Bible.** His first publishing of the Bible is the same as our present KING JAMES 1611 English Bible, except for word spellings and some same meaning words. Tyndale's Bible, Matthew's Bible produced by John Rogers, Coverdale's Bible, the Great or Chained Bible, the Geneva Bible, the Bishop's Bible-all said the same except for word spellings, due to changing of English spellings and some same meaning words that might mean the same like **big or giant**. They did not leave out, add and change meanings as all modern versions have. I have all of these unchanged English Bibles, and can tell you how to get all of these on internet and print them out free, and put them on a demonstration table to compare as we have done. Don't be lazy or careless, as your soul is at stake. You need to be intelligent and know what the Bible says and what the truth about Bible history. They have words spelled differently as English had not been established as how it would be spelled. Sometimes the word was spelled differently in the same verse. That was not a changeing of meaning nor an error. It made the language more international. They had the same verses and meanings. They were not like the over 400 modern copyrighted English contradicting themselves, and the Greek Textus Receptus used by King James 1611 translators. (Call me for the above information)

Some like the New King James make false statements about their Greek sources, and claim that they use older and better manuscripts or have found newer and better ones. When they speak of "variant readings" they are saying: "Yea hath God said"—or we have NO "Thus saith the Lord" thus causing much unbelief with lies and desire for money gain. So every few years they make a new changed edition to sell to students and many others not knowing they are using a changed and incorrect Bible. They leave out, add to and make verses say the opposite. Most Christians don't know what even one Bible version says, and are too inactive or lazy to compare these hundreds of changes in over 400 changed Bibles. Sorry-I wish this were not so.

16-A.D. 1530 - First French translation of the Bible.

17-A.D. 1535 - Myles Coverdale's Bible completed Tyndale's work, producing the first complete printed English Bible. Coverdale helped with five English translations: 1-Tyndale, 2-Matthew with Rogers, 3-Coverdale, 4-Great-Chained and the 5-Geneva Bible. He escaped death many times for his work, but his wife was burned for the faith..

18-A.D. 1536 - Martin Luther translated the Old Testament into the commonly spoken dialect of the German people, completing his translation of the entire Bible in German, from the Greek Textus Receptus.



19-A.D. 1536 - Tyndale was condemned as a heretic, strangled, and burned at the stake for putting the Bible in English. All those had God's Word and we??? Which?

All these 400 plus modern changed English versions-were not like Tyndale's. They have used the Roman Catholic Vaticanus that originally had only three chapters of Genesis, no Revelation, no Pauline epistles and ended at Hebrews 9:13, many, many plus leaving out verses and contradicting teaching salvation by works-like saying we are being saved instead are saved-as Ephesians 2:8 says and true Christians believe-by grace through faith and not of works.
