

**A**-The very fact that holiness and sin are named more times in the Bible than **love**, which everyone knows is a major component of Christianity, should speak to us about the importance of these two subjects.

To understand salvation and holiness, we must first understand that sin is the problem that Christ came to **solve.** So, what is sin? Some define sin as any deviation from the holiness of God and from His revealed will, either by action or condition. But the Bible says we can



be free from **sin**, that Jesus came to **save** us from our sin, that we can be preserved blameless and presented faultless. God's word declares an uttermost **salvation** from sin. So there must be another definition as it applies to us mortal creatures.

**B**-Our definition of sin: In the verses below you will see words like, "knoweth", "willfully", "transgression" etc., so our definition would read something like this: Sin is the willful (**deliberate**) breaking of the known



law of **God**. This can be done by

**omission** (failing to obey the plain command of God), or it can be done by committing **acts**, deeds or words that God has commanded us to abstain from. These are acts of disobedience or acts of

omitted righteousness. Both are committed in the heart and **will** of the individual.

The inevitable result of sin is death. First and of most consequence, is spiritual death, then in the end physical death.

# (P 22) Wages and the Gift:

forgiven and pardoned by His grace through faith. The second aspect of sin is the sin we were born with (the Adamic nature, the sin principle, carnality, the old man) are expressions that speak to the fact that men are born. Christiandom acknowledges man's inherited sin or deprayity.

**G**-Paul is writing about the human **depravity** that we are born with. God cannot forgive this sin, but rather it must be cleansed by the mighty baptism of the Spirit. This is the second work of God's amazing grace that is performed on the believer. It is the work of entire sanctification whereby the heart of the believer is cleansed from the inherited **pollution** of sin.

**H**-Sanctification means to make **holy**. In the New Testament, we are to separate ourselves from the world, sin, and ungodliness. This act of consecration is our **condition** upon which, through faith in the complete work of Calvary, God is able to purify our hearts and cleanse us from "all sin."

**B**-The first consideration for the Christian is to determine the will of God as it pertains to his or her life. If we can determine God's will in any matter, the course of action should be settled. To know the will of God is to do **it!** 



It is very plain in these verses, that God wants us to be holy **people** and live holy **lives** in this present and ungodly world.

After we determine the will of God in this matter of our holiness, then there comes the question of how do we, who are born in sin and with sin, go about allowing our great God and Savior Jesus Christ to cleanse and make us **holy?**

**D-**What is **next?** The next step is logical and

scriptural. As we begin to read the Bible and

pray over this matter of our personal holiness, we will begin to sense our need of this work of God as much as we needed the first work of forgiveness and being born into the family of God. God's Holy Spirit will help us to see our own heart and the **pride**, jealousy, greed or selfishness, self-will, lust and whatever is there that is unlike our Heavenly Father. Once we can see ourselves in need of this grace, it is easy to confess that need to God and ask Him to purify our **hearts** in love. You will want to pray for the Holy Spirit to show you any area of your heart or life that needs the work of the Spirit to cleanse

and make holy. As you confess and allow Him to search your heart, read the list of sins in the heart in Gal 5:19-21. Psalm 139:23-24-Search me, O God, and know my <a href="heart">heart</a>: try me, and know my thoughts: And see if there be any



wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

As the desire for a holy heart **increases**, the earnestness in prayer and seeking **intensifies** and you begin to yield to **God** the areas the Spirit brings to your mind. You will finally get to the place you want Him more than anything in this world.

**(P 24)** There may be in this process, on new light the Lord wants to give you; and He may want you to make some changes in your life in order for you to be a better witness and to bring glory to Him. And there may be areas in your life where you have not been, as diligent as you



should have been and He may lay it on your heart to get back to where you need to be with the light you already have.

**F**-Once the Lord is done making adjustments to your life and walk, and all restitutions that He has brought to you have been made, you are making real progress toward your personal Pentecost. You will need to forgive all who have wronged you and leave them in the hands of a just and holy God.

Unforgiveness is a spiritual cancer that has to be **removed** before spiritual health and progress can be made. One of the

keys to revival is: if there are walls or division among the people of God, there must be a coming together and reconciling with each other to allow the Spirit to move once again in our midst. This kind of humility has brought revival in many cases around the world. So if you know there is a



brother or sister who you have something against, forgive them. Go to them and ask their **forgiveness** and seek to be reconciled. This will bring the glory of God on your soul, and most likely on the church. Jesus clearly taught that we must forgive in order to be forgiven. Once you have taken care of all areas the Spirit has spoken to you about, then you will gladly come to the point of full **surrender** or complete consecration.



# (P 25) (4) Sanctification: The Way of Holiness and Conditions of Receiving the Holy Spirit:

# 1-Saved and in present victory:

**A**-Sanctification is for the believers **only** who are in a state of current victory and obedience to God. We have learned that willful disobedience is sin, and all willful sin must be confessed and forsaken in genuine repentance.



Anyone who has sin needs

forgiveness, which is the effectual part of the first work of grace. You are not ready for the second work until the first work is completed. In similar fashion; as a fourth grader who has not mastered the curriculum for the fourth grade is not ready to be promoted to the fifth. God works in a very orderly and systematic fashion and He has clearly laid out the plan for the believer to be **sanctified**. The first and foundational condition is that man be saved from all sin and walking in obedience to Jesus as Lord of their life. To

disregard this truth is to either: 1) accept a counterfeit form of **holiness** or 2) to despair while seeking to obtain

**holiness** when in reality, you need the victory that comes over sin in salvation.



# (P 28) Marriage: (part 2) The Covenant & Union:



I will consider the two-fold bond that takes place when two consenting adults, of their own free will, enter into the state of holy matrimony. One element is the

contract that both parties agree to in the presence of witnesses and in the presence of God. It is a solemn contract when they take their vows, and God considers them binding upon both parties until death should separate them. They promise to love the spouse above all others, to be faithful to their spouse, to cherish, and keep themselves only unto the other as long as they both shall live. These verses indicate how seriously **God** takes our vows:

It is only this side of the marriage that is broken when people are unfaithful or seek to dissolve their marriage by



means of divorce. Contracts are human instruments and, therefore, people feel they can be broken. They should not be broken. There was a day when a person's word was their bond, and their honor and reputation more important than personal convenience or wishes. Making a commitment and sticking to it used to be the norm. Sadly, it is not the case

today in this current culture. The other side of this twofold bond is the mystical union that God creates when these people pledge their devotion to each other. The scripture declares; Mark 10:7-9-For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and cleave to his wife: And they twain shall be one flesh: so then they are no more twain, but one flesh. What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder.

It speaks of God joining the two persons in an in-dissolvable union. So, even if the contract could be broken, this union which God Himself performs in this marriage is a life-long union. To the point,

that the Bible says, Rom 7:2, 3-For the woman which hath an husband is bound by the law to her husband so long as he **liveth**; but if the husband be dead, she is loosed from the law of her husband. So then if, while her husband liveth, she be married to another man, she shall be called an adulteress: but if her husband be dead, she is free from that law: so that she is no adulteress.

Paul, to the church at Ephesus speaks to this union between the man and wife as a type of the union that exists between Christ and His bride, the church.

Ephesians 5:30-32-For we are members of his **body**, of his flesh, and of his bones. For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh. This is a great

mystery: but I speak concerning Christ and the church.

As the believer becomes united with Christ, there is a joining with Him, and to Him, that makes us one with Him. As the Christian is united with Christ through love and the power of God working in us, so every man and woman who vow their love and devotion to one another are made one by the power of **God**. Physically, they are joined. It is during this when God performs His mystical union. This is another reason why couples should remain pure until marriage. Marriage then becomes a special and sacred event between the man and his wife.

There is even a chain of command or various roles within the triune Godhead. 1 Corinthians 11:3-But I would have you know, that the head of every man is **Christ**; and the head of the woman is the **man**; and the head of Christ is **God.** We see two things here: firstly, that there is a division of roles in the godhead, and secondly, the head or authority in every man's life and in every home must be Christ.

Does that make Christ inferior to the Father? No, it is simply His **role** to be in submission to the Father, even though they are co-equal in power, holiness,

**eternality.** When God outlines the roles of the husband and wife, it is not a matter of superiority or **inferiority.** it is a matter of roles and responsibilities. In Eph 5:23-For the husband is the head of the wife, even as **Christ** is the head of the church. He is the Savior of the body.



And in Timothy 5:14-I will therefore that the younger women marry, bear children, guide the house, give none occasion to the adversary to speak reproachfully.

The man, under **normal** circumstances, should be the provider for the household. There are certain situations where this is not feasible, but it is my understanding that it should be the norm, and not the exception.

The Bible here deals with shepherding and sheep, both of which are common Old Testament teachings and very familiar to the people.

The door to the sheepfold was a narrow entrance to a sheltered area where the sheep would be bedded down for the night. When the sheep were safely in the fold, the shepherd would lay down across the entrance and even sleep there between his flock and any adversaries.

Darkness is, in essence, the **absence** of light. Spiritual darkness is the absence of spiritual light, or the absence of God. Darkness and light are totally incompatible. They **cannot** exist side by side. Truth and error, good and evil, heaven and hell, sin and salvation, are all mutually exclusive of each other. It is one or the other, never both at the same time.

You must surrender yourself and your situations to Him. The devil, on the other hand, is called by Jesus a thief. Once we have, of our own will, surrendered and submitted the keeping of our souls to God through Christ, we are then ready and willing to be washed in His blood and made clean **through** His sacrifice. James 4:8-Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded. Come to Him for the cleansing and purifying that only He can provide. You need to establish a relationship with Him before you expect Him to fight your battles for you. Your enemies, your addictions, your bondages, and battles are mainly brought on by sin. Sin is the first **enemy** Christ wants to destroy in your life. Until you allow Him to deal with your sin, you cannot have Christ.

# Point 4-Battle of the ages,

between good and evil: The first key to success is to draw nigh to God. Move as close to Him as you can get. Get into His presence, His favor, humbly entreat Him to mold you and hold you in the hollow of His hand.



### Point 5: A-Fight-Resist the devil.

The word literally means to oppose him.

Do not **bow** in fear and hunker down in doubt. Stand up to him in the name and strength of your Savior. Do not try to ignore him and expect him to go away. Do not ever try to reason with him or debate with



him. You cannot win that way. James 4:7-Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. I Peter 5:8-Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring **lion**, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:

1 Peter 5:9-Whom resist stedfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren.

This resistance must be whole hearted! No wavering, no "maybe I want to do or listen to this suggestion." 100% unwavering. No giving in to the devil and sin.

**B-This resistance** must be made not in your name or power, but in the name and power of Jesus Christ. Your faith in this Name and power are also essential to your success in this battle. God will slay our giants if we will fight in His name and with His power.



# C-Our two greatest weapons are

the blood of Jesus and the **Word** of God. Freely incorporate both into your resistance against the enemy of your soul. Rev 12:10-And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven,



Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

Rev. 12:11-And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their **testimony**; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

Jesus gave us clear example in His temptation and conflict with the devil, "it is written". We should prepare our hearts and minds to use the Word of God against the devil.

And secondly, **resist** these feelings, fears, and doubts. Know your enemy. Study his tactics and devices. 2 Cor 2:11-Lest Satan should get an advantage of us.

**(P 40)** Far too many people are unconcerned and unconscious of the reality of a living spirit called the devil. The Bible has much to say about him. Will we take the Bible seriously? I am not here to



promote him, applaud him, or make him appear bigger than he is. Eph 6:11-Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. Eph 6:12-For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Prepare for war with him. Protect yourself with the whole armor of God. You are not fighting human forces. You are contending with rulers of darkness. Think about who you are up against. Practice part one of the battle plan. Run to Jesus and let Him fight for you. Wiles are cunning arts, deceit, craft, and trickery. You do not have to understand the powers of darkness nor delve into all that is spiritual wickedness in

order to fight this fight of faith. You should not try to know all about the devil and his power, as that is a danger in itself.

John 8:44-Ye are of your father the **devil**, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own, for he is a liar, and the father of lies.

I John 3:10-In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God, neither he that loveth not his brother. Look closely at the control the enemy is able to grasp. The Bible labels us either children of God or children of the devil. Don't overlook another trait you need to get firmly established in your mind. The devil is a liar. You dare not believe him.

This control becomes really serious when you consider these verses. 2 Tim 2:25, 26 say: In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will. 2 Cor 4-In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them. **Satan** has the power to snare and blind the minds of the ones who do not believe. Do you understand why the world has gone morally and spiritually insane? The god of this world has blinded them to spiritual truth and reality and they are insensitive to God's light. This is a horrible tragedy. Any occult activity opens your mind to satanic influences.

**14-**Who has power to blind minds? **Sa\_** ultimately, satanic control. This is no game, it is not a joke, it is heaven or hell. I beg of you, don't play with your souls. Run to Jesus, get under the blood of Christ! Pray! Walk in His light!

In these last days, another thing you want to be aware of is the rise of spiritual miracles performed by Satan himself. Satan will raise the **dead**, do healings, many counterfeit miracles.

2 Thes 2:8-10-And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming: Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders, And with all deceit of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received

not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. Matthew

shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect. Many, if not all, of the last day, end-time, satanic miracles will be religious counterfeits like false prophets and false Christs. The Bible gives us the reason so many will be deceived saying "they received not the love of the truth." 2 Cor 11:14-And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. Satan comes against true believers with impressions, suggestions, temptations to spiritual pride, tempting us to get ahead of the will of God, or out of the will of God, all the while posing as a messenger of light and heaven. Here is where we need to know the truth; We need to have such a love for God and truth, and be living as close as we possibly can, so

24:24-There shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and

we will be able to discern the voice of an impostor. The devil is relentless: you must fight in the power of God, and prepare yourself with every form of armor to withstand this enemy. If you



think I am exalting the devil, that is not my purpose. My goal is to warn us of the seriousness of this conflict, and the terrible consequences of not knowing or being able to win in this spiritual warfare.

John 10:4, 5-And when he putteth forth his own sheep, he goeth before them, and the sheep follow him: for they know his voice. And a stranger will they not follow, but will flee

from him: for they know not the voice of strangers. Let me leave you with this from Isa 59:19-So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD



shall lift up a **standard** against him. Isa 59:20-And the Redeemer shall come to Zion, and unto them that turn from transgression in Jacob, saith the LORD.
