

Park Rules

Departures: Check out is at 10am.

Accounts: Accounts are to be paid in full upon arrival and no refunds will be issued for early departures.

Speed Limit: 10km or walking pace. Please drive carefully at all times and look out for children and pushbikes.

Water: Please be water wise while staying at the park as we are under water restrictions. Turn water supply off when leaving site and at night.

Electricity: One 15 Amp power supply to each site / Semi permanent or permanent van.

Regulations: All guests, visitors, semi-permanents and permanents must comply with the Caravan Parks and Camping Grounds Regulations 1997.

Pets: Dogs must be always kept on a leash and supervised at all times Please clean up after your dog and place waste in bins provided. Excessive barking will not be tolerated, and you may be asked to remove your dog from the park. No visitors' dogs allowed. No pets are allowed inside the accommodation.

Motor Vehicles: One motor vehicle per site. If you have extra vehicles, please contact the office to make parking arrangements. The operation of any motor vehicle (including quad bikes) under the influence of alcohol is strictly prohibited on park premises and you will be removed from the park.

Quad Bikes: Quad bikes are only to be used in the park when commuting from accommodation to the beach. Joy rides on park premises are not allowed.

Visitors: All visitors must sign in at the office prior to entering the park.

Cabins: Please leave the kitchen as you found it. Wash, dry and return all dishes to their allocated areas. All breakages and damages must be reported to Management prior to your departure.

Camp Sites: Upon reaching your site, please advise us immediately of any damage to the utility services. Upon exit from your site please turn off the water tap and electricity connection.

Rubbish: Please place all your rubbish in a bag before putting in the provided wheelie bins.

Noise: Quiet time is from 9pm to 7am. Noise must be kept to minimum during these times and please be conscious of your neighbours. Noise complaints by your neighbours to management may result in you being asked to leave the park.

The noise from music or social gatherings should be at a level as to not disturb or interfere with the enjoyment of other guests or residents.

Anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated and will result in you being asked to leave the park immediately.

Ablutions: Children must be supervised at all time. The washing of clothes or dishes in the abluion blocks is prohibited.

Dump Point: The dump point is located at the Cnr Hopetoun Ravensthorpe Road & Senna Rd, Hopetoun. The disposal of chemical toilet contents in the park ablutions is prohibited.

Laundry: Laundry facilities are located behind the camp kitchen and the western end of the park. Washing machines use 6 x \$1 coins. Change is available at the office. Laundry is open 24/7

Camp kitchen: BBQ, fridge, microwave, kettle and toaster are provided for your convenience. Please respect your fellow campers and clean up after using the facilities. All food must be labelled when placing in the fridge.

Children: Parents are responsible for their children at all times. Children riding scooters, bikes or skateboards do so at their own risk.

Fish cleaning: Fish cleaning area is located behind the park storage shed. No fish offal is to be placed in bins.

Smoking: It is illegal to smoke inside enclosed public buildings. No smoking within 5 metres of communal areas. Smoking is also strictly forbidden in all of our holiday accommodation. A \$200 cleaning fee applies if there is smoking in the holiday accommodation.
