# BEARDED QUEEN PAGEANT

## PAGEANT RULES

Pageant Coordinator will begin accepting packets one hour before the start of the Pageant. Packet must be turned in to the Pageant Coordinator by 10 minutes before start time on the night of the pageant. If your packet is turned in later than this time, it will be considered as a "Late Entry".

Late entries will be accepted up until the start time of the pageant. However, 50 points will be deducted from the final score of the late entrant.

All contestants are required to bring two (2) auction items to be auctioned off during the pageant. This is what keeps the pageant free from entrance fees. If auction items are not brought by a contestant, 100 points per item will be deducted from their final score.

Contestants may **not** use any fireworks, sharp tools, knives, or weapons of any kind. Also, contestants may **not** use any other device that may cause harm to themselves or any other member of the audience or any other contestant or contestant's helper. No total nudity will be tolerated.

Space is limited in the dressing room. All contestants are asked to leave the dressing area as soon as you are dressed for the next category.

**No use or sale of any illegal substance will be tolerated.** Any contestant or helper caught breaking this rule will result in immediate disqualification of that contestant.

**Theft will not be tolerated.** Any contestant or helper caught breaking this rule will result in immediate disqualification of that contestant.

The winner of this pageant will perform their first number as the new Reigning soon after being crowned, (please submit the number you will be doing upon turning in your packet, just in case you are the winner) and is required to be a part of at least one (1) event (show, or meeting, or Samaritan House Dinner Club, or Cookout, or other function) per month during their reigning year. The winner is also required to perform at and crown the new winner of the next year's pageant. Failure to fulfill these obligations may result in suspension and/or removal of title and/or crown, or both.

Tippling is allowed and encouraged during all judged categories of the pageant.

Judged categories are as follows:

(A): Presentation – 150 points possible

(B): Evening Wear & Q/A -- 150 points possible

(C): Talent – 200 points possible
