The course covers green cleaning standards, such as the Green Seal 42 *Environmental Standard for Commercial and Institutional Cleaning Services*(GS42), the *Cleaning Industry Management Standard Green Build*(CIMS GB), and the Green Cleaning requirements found in the *LEED O&M* Standard.

Successful completion of the course provides the student with a numbered document of certification as a *Certified Eco Building Hygienist™*, a laminated photo ID certification card and a CEBH logo badge.
