# WORDS FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

2024 started off with a bang as we were in the midst of our Divas & Dragoons concert series. In the depth of our Winnipeg winter, MUO brought ostentatious joy mixing live opera singing with our incredible local drag community.

We continued our expanded season format, established in 2023, with *Unwritten*. This carefully curated balance of reinvention and reverence featured written works that were transformed into opera. Our tour show was MUO's first original show, *Playtime*, with a new libretto penned by Max Fingerote.

Our success can be seen in a 30% increase in patrons and very favorable reviews. There is an appetite for our work and we can't wait to keep pushing boundaries.

Our Neighbourhood Opera Tour spent a record seven weeks on tour and traveled outside Manitoba for the first time. Notable new locations included reserves above the 53rd parallel and partnerships with charities including BGC, Arts AccessAbility Network Manitoba, and Art City.

Financially, we received more than \$200,000 once again with a healthy surplus to replenish our reserves and plan for the future. Our public grants, box office, and donations all saw record increases.

None of this would be possible without our beloved supporters. Thank you to our donors, sponsors, government agencies, and patrons. You believed in us, championed us, and celebrated what opera can be. Beyond that, you have demonstrated unwavering trust in our artistic vision. We can't wait to show you more.


