You must pass two temperament tests, under two different judges to receive the AKC Temperament title.

Testing Information

- Dogs may **NOT** wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars or harnesses that restrict movement for tests.
- Dogs may wear slip collars on a dead ring, buckle collars, body harness or martingales. Leashes should be 4ft. to 6ft. long and should be made of fabric or leather.
- The use of food is not permitted. The use of clickers is not permitted. The use of toys as rewards is not permitted. You may talk to and encourage your dog, but not excessively. No verbal or leash corrections.
 - No luring of dog (no use of imaginary food).
- Entered dogs will not be permitted into the testing area until their testing time.
- Soiling the ring is an automatic dismissal.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form for each event/test in which it is entered.
- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- Participants will be given time for their test which will be emailed to them prior to the trial. Anyone missing their time will be moved to the end of the testing line.
- Dogs are tested at Owner's sole risk. During the testing, dogs are required to navigate obstacles. Please see the AKC website for ATT testing requirements.
- **Bitches known to be season must always wear diapers and must eliminate themselves away from testing area.**
- There is limited room for spectators. All spectators must stand well back from the testing area and not act as a distraction to the dogs being tested.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless they are being tested.
- A fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing, or an exhibitor caught not picking up after their dog.
- The grounds are not completely fenced.
- You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children at all times.
- This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly. Please bring your own shade, chairs, and water.

AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.

Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC/HCTC/ GKC/ dog(s) or person(s) will be asked to leave the testing site by the Field Committee, maybe disciplined by the AKC, and entry fees will not be refunded.

No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club. The Doberman Pinscher Club of Columbus Ohio will be following all Federal, State, Local, and AKC suggested guidelines to keep volunteers and testing participants safe.

Directions

From the South: take I-N to SR 30, go West on 30 to SR 39N (Shelby Exit). Turn left at Main Street in Shelby, turn right at Gamble Street, this is SR 61N. Take 61N to Preston Road. Turn left onto Preston. Go to 2nd stop sign. You can see the venue across the street. Follow signs for parking.

From the North: Take I-71S to SR 224 exit in Lodi. Go West on SR 224 until you get to New Haven. This is the intersection of SR224 & SR 61. Turn left on SR61. Go through Plymouth, take a slight right onto SR 98. Approximately 2.5 mi on right, watch for signs and parking.

From the West: Take SR 30 to Bucyrus. Take the SR 98 exit. The venue is 18 miles on your left. watch for signs and parking.

From the East: Take SR 30 into Mansfield. Go West on 30 to SR 39N (Shelby exit). Turn Left at Main Street in Shelby, turn right at Gamble Street, this is SR 61N. Take RS61 N to Preston Rd. Turn left onto Preston. Go to the 2nd stop sign. You can see the venue across the street, follow signs for parking.

DO NOT PARK IN THE YARD. ALL VEHICLES MUST BE PARKED IN THE ADJOINING FIELD.

Overnight camping/RV parking with NO hookups is permitted. No reservations needed. 2024 camping fee is \$20 per night prepaid.

Porta-Johns will be available. Please bring your own chair, food, shade and water for you and your dog(s).
